18 Lynne Blaisdell said the BOS need to finalize the acceptance of Sue Reynolds  
19 as the Recording Secretary for Cynthia's leave of absence at the rate of \$18.56  
20 per hour.

21 Lynne mentioned that for previous recoding secretaries they have been a  
22 contractor for the Town but there taxes taken out of their wages. Lynne said  
23 after looking into this she found that you can't do both. There was a bit of a  
24 discussion as to whether Sue would be a contractor for the Town or an  
25 employee of the Town. The consensus of the Board is to have her be a town  
26 employee. Lynne suggested they review the job description at a future date.  
27 Sue said her plan is to submit the minutes by the following weekend.

29 Lynne Blaisdell said the Cable Access Board works off of Franchise Fees and  
30 have asked the BOS to grant the Cable employees a 2% increase effective April  
31 1, 2015. Lynne said this will affect Chris Donnellan, Daniel Peters and Cheryl  
32 Eastman.

33 Litigation - Lynne Blaisdell mentioned the Board gave Cindy permission to  
34 speak with attorney Eghart about the feasibility study and consolidation up to  
35 \$500.00. Lynne said he contacted Lynne to be sure this was ok. Lynne handed  
36 out some paperwork to the Board and asked that they discuss this next week.
