They were able to raise \$807.99 to purchase gas cards for the drivers of the program. Paul also thanked the BOS support.
20 27 28 29 30 31	NEW BUSINESS 2015 Municipal Energy Efficiency Workshop at Eversourse Lynne said she attended the workshop and felt there were a few things that the Town could take advantage of this year. She stated it was unfortunate as to the timing of the workshop as they have grant money available but most of

it is matching funds and there wasn't any money put in the budget for it. She

- did say that Eversourse was informed of this at the time of the workshop and
- they may look to change the dates of future workshops. Lynne gave the BOS a
- copy of the presentation and explained that just from switching Florescent
- lights to LED will save the Town a substantial amount of money in the longrun. Lynne feels the Board should take advantage of the offer to purchase a
- run. Lynne feels the Board should take advantage of the offer to purchase a
 new water heater. Lynne is asking the Board's permission to look into pricing
- for a new on demand water heater. The BOS are granting that permission at
- this time. Lynne said she can have a project manager from Eversource come
- and talk to the BOS about changing all of the lighting out to the LED lights.
- 42 Lynne also stated there is an outdoor light that lights up the parking lot in the
- 43 library that is not working. Lynne said that Selectman Tombarello and Ron
- 44 Dulong looked into this and it could be a quick fix of a \$50.00 bulb but they
- 45 really need to look into it a bit deeper to see if the ballast needs to be replaced.
- Lynne asked permission to look into putting up 2 new lights in separate areas so the entire parking lot will be lit. Lynne said it will cost about \$150.00 per

65 Volunteer Worker's Agreement

- ⁶⁶ Lynne said a few years ago the BOS created a community service waiver while
- working anywhere in Town. She said there have been some issues raised with
- the building of the new police station and they would like people know what
- the expectation of the Town is regarding coverage. Lynne stated that the

⁷⁰ person's primary insurance will be the main source of coverage and anything

- over that the Town has a \$10,000 policy to cover the difference. Lynne said
- one of the forms would waive the Town's liability and it would acknowledge
- the coverage they would receive. Lynne said the second form is general
- ⁷⁴ information as to who are they doing work for and what they would be doing
- ⁷⁵ for work. Lynne would like approval from the BOS to begin using these forms.
- 76 Selectwoman Buco asked if this was for job site volunteers and Lynne said this
- is for anyone that volunteers doing physical work for the Town. Selectman
- Goldman said he understands why it is being done but feels it will deter
 volunteers from coming forward to help. He feels the Town should be
- responsible if a volunteer gets hurt while volunteering. Lynne said that the
- insurance company has approved this and they actually provided most of the
- wording for it. Selectman Buco feels it is good to have so that all expectations
- are known up front. Lynne said that she doesn't want volunteers to be
- discouraged but something like this protects the Town. Selectman Devine
- guestioned the confidential clause on the paperwork and Lynne said
- sometimes there are volunteers that have access to private information of
- ⁸⁷ individuals within the Town and they needs to remember that everything they
- see and hear is confidential. Selectman Goldman does not agree to the
- \$10,000.00 cap and Lynne said it would be up to the BOS to decide if they
- 90 wanted to pay for the additional medical expenses. Selectman Devine asked
- Lynne to look into a \$50,000.00 policy and ask the Town attorney their
- opinion on using this as well. Selectwoman Buco said this is just a baseline
- ⁹³ and they can take them case by case.

Selectman Goldman said that he received a phone call from a concerned 111 resident in regards to the school budget process. He stated at one of the 112 School Board meetings it was discussed that the sprinkler system at Sandown 113 North would be put in this year with the surplus monies from last year's 114 budget. The concerned resident is asking the BOS what is being done about 115 this and if the sprinklers are being installed or not. She feels they are not 116 going to get installed because of the feasibility study. Selectman Goldman said 117 at this point the assumption is that the sprinklers are not going to be installed 118 because of the potential of Sandown pulling out of the district. He said while 119 he was looking into this he found that Danville went to the School Board 120 because they have concerns as far as money coming out of surplus to pay for 121 items within the budget. He is bringing this to the BOS to get their opinion. 122 Selectwoman Buco asked if the building meets the standards of the Dept. of 123 Education without the sprinkler system. She also said that only a study is 124 being conducted at this time and even if Sandown decided to leave the district 125 it wouldn't be or several years. She said there is a safety concern now, as far 126 as she is concerned the sprinklers should be put in now as it is just a study 127 that is being done. She also said that if Sandown does decide to leave the 128 district this is something that could be negotiated at that time and would be 129 part of the withdrawal recommendation. Arthur Green and Cathy Gorman 130 came to the table to speak on this behalf. Arthur said that back on December 131 23, 2014 the Budget Committee was assured by the administrator that the 132 sprinkler system would be installed whether or not it was appropriated in the 133 2015/16 budget. He said they were told it would be done either with money 134 from the budget or money from surplus. Arthur continued to say that had the 135 School Budget not made that assurance to the Budget Committee, he feels the 136 Budget Committee probably would not have cut that money out of the budget 137 proposal. Cathy Gorman stated that residents should not be asking the BOS if 138 the sprinkler system is going to be put in and paid for. She said the residents 139 should be going to their elected Town School Board representatives for that 140 information. Cathy also said this is a requirement by law and if the study is 141 completed and Sandown decides not to pull out of the district then the Town 142 is liable for that cost as they are still in the district. She said if Sandown does 143 withdraw from the district then it may be part of the negotiations but it is the 144

- Lynne said that she tried to put the numbers in with the titles but it was
- difficult to put them in all of the boxes. She said that she did it for the elected
- 152 personnel and asked if the numbers are really needed. Selectman Treanor
- 153 feels the numbers are not needed and Selectman Devine agreed.
- 154 Selectman Tombarello has arrived.
- 155 Selectman Tombarello said he is good with the way the chart looks at time.
- 156 *Motion by* Selectman Tombarello to implement the organizational chart that
- was adopted on December 17, 2007 and changed on May 11, 2015.

163 **Discussion to invite TRHS Chairman to a future meeting**

- Lynne said a few weeks ago there was some discussion as to whether the BOS
- 165 wanted to invite the TRHS Chairman to a future meeting to ask questions in
- regards to the feasibility study and other concerns of the Town. Lynne saidthat some of the questions have been generated. Selectman Tombarello said
- that some of the questions have been generated. Selectman Tombarello sa
 he would like to review the questions and have some of them removed.
- 169 Selectwoman Buco stated this is was just a first rough draft of the questions
- and wanted to include a lot of the questions that were asked over the past
- year. She also said after further review she would like to remove questions 7,
- 172 8, 9, 10 & 12. Selectman Goldman asks what the goal is of the BOS because if it
- is in regards to the consolidation then he feels Lee Dube should come before
- the BOS to address that. He also stated that when he was asked to be on the
- committee he said that he didn't have time and offered Selectman Devine to
- take his place a selectman. He was told that he was wanted on the committeeas a parent and he said he would consider it as he would only be able to attend
- meeting when he could and would not commit to every meeting. He said this
- message was not passed onto the consolidation committee as they felt
- 180 Selectman Goldman was not pulling his weight on the committee. He stated
- 181 up front that Tuesday's were not good for him and he was only able to attend
- 182 1 meeting. Selectman Goldman suggested to invite Lee Dube to next week's

meeting to give the BOS an update. Selectwoman Buco said the School Board 183 is responsible for everything that happens in the district and it is Nancy 184 Steensen that drives the district and feels it isn't fair to put Lee Dube on the 185 spot. Selectman Tombarello suggested talking to Kelly Ward in regards to this 186 as well. Selectwoman Buco said he has been invited to all of the meetings that 187 updates were given and he has chosen not to attend. Selectman Devine agrees 188 with Selectman Goldman to invite Lee Dube and Kelly Ward to a meeting to 189 give the BOS an update on the Consolidation Committee and the Feasibility 190 Study. There was a brief discussion in regards to the questions and then 191 Selectman Devine asked that a subcommittee be formed to review the 192 questions that will be presented. He also asked that a request go out to Kelly 193 Ward and Donna Green inviting them to a future meeting to answer the BOS 194 questions. Then it was decided that there would be special BOS meeting on 195 Wednesday night at 7pm to discuss the questions. Selectman Tombarello 196 asked the Cathy Gorman, Arthur Green and Tony Piemonte join the BOS to 197 discuss the question at the Wednesday night meeting and Selectman Devine 198 agreed. 199 Selectwoman Buco asked permission from the BOS to form a minority 200 committee from the Feasibility Study Committee. She said there first meeting 201 is this Thursday and she said there is a lot of misinformation being put on 202 Facebook in regards to several things and said the postings are from other 203 Town Committee members that are on the Feasibility Study Committee. She 204 said she is concerned that conclusions have already been drawn and the study 205 hasn't even begun. She feels it is imperative that the minority committee 206 should be created so the study is done fairly and honestly for the residents of 207 Sandown. Selectman Devine said he is ok with a minority committee being 208 formed and Selectman Tombarello agrees. Selectwoman Buco said that she is 209 looking for Sandown residents to submit letters of intent to the committee for 210 1 week. She said she has already received some letters of interest that she will 211 be bringing to the Feasibility Study Committee. Selectwoman Buco is looking 212 for a full Board support of the minority committee. Cathy Gorman is in 213 support of the minority committee as well as she has concerns regarding the 214 information being publicized on social media and wants to be sure the 215 outcome of the study is thorough and that it is transparent to the Town of 216 Sandown. Selectman Goldman asked if there will be minutes posted from the 217 Feasibility Study Committee meetings and Selectman Buco said yes there will 218 be. Selectman Goldman asked if Selectman Buco wanted to be appointed the 219 chair of the minority committee and Selectman Devine said that appointment 220

- is up to the majority committee. Selectman Devine said once the majority
- committee is formed, then the minority committee is formed from that
- committee. Selectman Devine then said that once the majority committee is
- formed and she wants to start a minority then she can entertain the letters of
- interest that she has received. Cathy Gorman feels strongly that there is a
 minority committee formed and there needs to be minutes from both the
- majority and minority committee and wants to know where the minutes will
- be posted. Cathy feels the School Board will be taking and posting minutes
- from the majority committee and Selectman Devine stated that it is up to the
- School Board to take minutes from both committees and have them posted in
- the same places. Selectman Devine asked that the minutes be posted on theTown's website and Lynne Blaisdell stated that that is not something that they
- would post on the Town website. Selectman Devine asked her to locate the
- written copy of this as it might need to be amended. Selectman Goldman feels
- the minutes from both committees should be posted on the school's website.
- 236 Selectman Goldman asked Selectman Buco to see where the minutes will be
- posted at the initial majority committee meeting. Cathy Gorman reminded the
- BOS that this was a warrant article that was voted on by the residents of
- 239 Sandown and there is an obligation to the residents to keep them well
