27 Selectman Tombarello said that he met with Superintendent Metzl	_

- BOS have questions for the TRSB and he told Selectman Tombarello that they
- will answer the questions but they will not be coming to a meeting.
- 35 Selectman Devine said that this meeting will take place for 1 hours and the
- questions that will be asked will not be argumentative.
- 37 Selectman Devine said that he would like question 1 to be asked, which is, Will
- the minutes of the Consolidation Committee be made available to the public
- 39 along with the results?
- Selectman Devine also stated that the consolidated work is vitally important
- to our Town and citizens as a member of the School District. Cathy Gorman
- suggested to word things as a member of the District and not the Town as it
- will not be entertained by the School Board.
- Selectman Devine would like question 2 to be asked, which is, How do you
- arrive at a non-public meeting?
- 46 Cathy Gorman feels their response will be that it is not a School Board
- 47 Committee and it is a Superintendent's Advisory Board and it is not subject to
- the right to know. Cathy would like to know why the School Board doesn't
- consider this a Board sanctioned Committee that is needed to produce a plan
- 50 based on their vote of consolidating the schools. Arthur Green feels that
- Nancy Steensen should be able to speak to this matter as the Chairman of the
- 52 School Board. Selectman Tombarello suggested to talk to Kelly Ward first and
- ask these questions to him prior to going directly to the School Board. Lynne
- Blaisdell suggested that the BOS go to the School Board with the questions.
- Arthur Green feels that when you have concerns you should go on record with
- them and feels the entire School Board should be emailed. Selectman Devine
- asked Cathy Gorman what the policy is to reach all School Board members and
- 58 Cathy said that policy is to email information to the School Board email
- address and that goes directly to Nancy Steensen, the Chair of the School
- 60 Board and also to Superintendent Metzler. Cathy said the School Board
- 61 members to do not see it until it is in the correspondence folder. Selectman
- Devine said that was unacceptable and Cathy Gorman again suggested sending
- the information directly to all School Board members and not just to the group
- email or only to the Chair. Lynne Blaisdell suggested the BOS ask to be put on
- a future agenda as email is not a proper way to conduct Town business.
- 66 Selectman Devine suggests developing the questions now and sending them to
- the School Board ahead of time so they have time to review them before the
- 68 BOS attend a School District meeting. Arthur Green refers to Danville wanting
- to speak on the impact fees of their Town and they were told they could come

- to a meeting and speak during public input and there was no interaction from
- the School Board. Arthur Green said after a period of time the Danville
- representative was invited back to speak during the School Board meeting.
- 73 Selectman Goldman has arrived.
- Selectman Devine asked when the report is due and Arthur Green said on May
- 75 21st Superintendent Metzler will be making recommendations to the School
- Board with taking into consideration the information presented by the
- Advisory Committee. Arthur continued to say that he heard that at time the
- Committee's report is going to be released but he is not sure if this will be the
- report from the Committee of it will be altered by the Superintendent first.
- 80 Selectman Goldman said that the report is due on May 20th and
- Superintendent Metzler will have the Committee make the presentation
- themselves on the 21st. Selectman Devine said he'd like to be on that agenda
- under correspondence. Cathy Gorman asked what the legal ramifications are
- if the meetings were supposed to be held in public. Selectman Devine said
- nothing, it has already taken place and the BOS need to wait until it is
- presented to the School Board and decide if they want to challenge it or not.
- 87 Selectman Goldman suggested to state their displeasure with the way the
- meetings were held without minutes and not in public and they would like
- 89 this not to continue.
- 90 Selectwoman Buco has arrived.
- Selectman Devine said he would sit with Lynne to develop the rest of the
- 92 questions and comments. Selectwoman Buco said the questions as written
- were just a rough draft and would expect some of the wording to be changed.
- Cathy Gorman said she would like to know the recommendations moving
- 95 forward as they came from the committee. She also said he received an email
- 96 from Nancy Steensen saying any and all documents produced by the
- 97 Committee were available to the public. Selectman Goldman said they need to
- wait to see what happens with the report being released first and he also said
- there hasn't been any talk that he aware of about the report not being
- released. Selectman Tombarello said he has recommendations for questions
- 2-5. He said for question 2, it should read, How may superintendent advisory
- committee's will undercut the responsibility of the School Board and do you
- plan to put an end to that? Selectman Goldman doesn't feel this needs to be
- asked as Selectman Devine has a statement in regards to the BOS being
- displeased with the way the meetings have been run and what is the
- policy/oversight going forward? Question 3, Cathy Gorman suggested to add
- what were the recommendations from the Advisory Committee opposed to

the recommendations being presented. Selectman Goldman feels that 108 Question 4 is ok except to remove Can the town of Sandown expect the same 109 treatment as they will be speaking to them at that time. Question 5, The BOS 110 agree to leave this question as is. Selectman Tombarello thinks that Question 111 6 is ok except to remove "an agenda that you can control". Arthur Green feels 112 it dilutes the impact of what the BOS are doing if they bring in issues with how 113 the School District runs their meetings. Selectman Goldman agrees with 114 Arthur Green and feels that Question 6 may need to be removed. Selectman 115 Devine said this is not a Home Rule State. Cathy Gorman wants to know how 116 the Town of Sandown gets their questions answered. Arthur Green says there 117 is a much bigger problem which is, Is Sandown's representation being 118 adequately attended to by the School Board, given Mrs. Green's inability to get 119 answers to the questions she has asked. He is very concerned as Sandown's 120 representation is being undercut by the lack of respect that is provided to the 121 questions that are being asked by the elected representative. He feels this is 122 very pertinent for the BOS to ask the School Board when they attend a 123 meeting. Cathy Gorman suggested to send the final questions to Donna Green 124 and Kelly Ward and cc the School Board chair and let her know you are 125 addressing your School Board Representatives via correspondence that will 126 appear in the correspondence folder. She suggests telling them you want the 127 questions raised at the School Board meeting as a concern. Arthur Green also 128 suggests to cc the entire School Board as well. Selectman Goldman feels this is 129 a good idea and maybe Donna and Kelly can work together on the questions 130 prior to the next School Board meeting. Selectman Devine said this will be 131 brought up again at the next BOS meeting to finalize the questions and come 132 up with a format as to how they will be delivered. Selectman Devine asked if 133 the BOS would like to invite Kelly Ward and Donna Green to the next BOS 134 meeting to discuss the questions and Selectman Goldman said yes as long as 135 they know what the questions are going to be. Arthur Green said Donna has a 136 prior commitment on Monday nights so she would not be able to make the 137 meeting but he is sure she would be willing to raise the questions. The BOS 138 will draft a letter to Kelly Ward and Donna Green and will be cc'd to the School 139 Board via mail and email. Donna Green and Kelly Ward will also be invited to 140 the next BOS meeting. Lynne said there is no need for them to come in if the 141 Board is sending them a letter. It was suggested that they know ahead of time 142 that the letter is coming. Selectman Buco said none of this should be 143 questions as a plan should have been in place prior to it being put on the 144 warrant. She said when she asked this question to Legal Counsel the final 145

response was "the district administration had a duty to plan out how it would 146 educate Sandown children before placing an article on the warrant". She said 147 all of this controversy is a direct reflect of how this was managed from the 148 beginning and feels it was a big failure. Tony Piemonte said he was the one 149 that created the article and it has been over 60 days and he hasn't heard 150 anything yet and Selectman Devine said they have 180 days and it starts once 151 the Committee is formed, and that will be tomorrow night. Selectman Buco 152 said they just got the meeting agenda today. Selectman Buco read the email 153 that she wrote to Nancy Steensen to the BOS along with her response, which 154 was Selectman Buco letting Nancy Steensen know that she was going to be on 155 the Feasibility Study Committee and she was interested in the work from the 156 Consolidation Committee as it will affect the Feasibility study and Sandown 157 residents. She also asked her for the minutes of the Consolidation Committee 158 meetings or where she can find them on line as they have already met a few 159 times and she also asked when the next meeting was so that she could attend 160 and get the information for herself without having to obtain minutes from 161 someone else. Nancy's response was that the Consolidation Committee is not 162 a Board Committee she has no authority over it and she doesn't have the 163 answers to her questions as she is not on that Committee. She continued to 164 say that it is an Advisory Committee to the Superintendent and the minutes 165 cannot be found online nor is the public invited to attend because they are not 166 public meetings, nor are they subject to the same policies and RSA's as both 167 committees. Selectwoman Buco said this is the complete opposite of an email 168 that she received from Kelly Ward saying that all of the meetings were public. 169 Cathy Gorman said she is concerned as there is no School Board oversight to 170 this committee. Selectman Goldman referred to an email he received by Kelly 171 Ward on April 24th that said that all meetings were held in public as no one 172 voted to keep the meetings non-public. He went on to say that the public was 173 always welcome to attend as well as all documents created were made public. 174 Selectman Goldman said he didn't think the minutes were ever posted and if 175 they were public meetings he would have expected minutes and doesn't think 176 there are any. Selectman Goldman said he attended the Committee's second 177 meeting and remembered a discussion on keeping the information non-public 178 because there were concerns about the committee talking about potentially 179 changing classrooms, etc. and having teachers getting upset as this was just in 180 the talking stages. 181 Selectman Devine said that he and Lynne will sit down and develop the 182

questions and they will be presented to the BOS at the next meeting for

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review. Once the letter is written it will go out to the Sandown 184 Representatives, Kelly Ward and Donna Green and the Board will move 185 forward. He thanks Cathy Gorman, Arthur Green and Tony Piemont form 186 coming to the meeting. Arthur Green said he would like to plan to be at the 187 BOS meeting and give his input on the questions as well. 188 189 Cathy Gorman asked the BOS if they are planning to attend the next School 190 Board meeting.
