## 71 Bridge on Phillips Rd.

- 72 Selectman Devine said the town was instructed by the State after it was
- <sup>73</sup> inspected. He said there is State aide for rebuilding bridges but the
- <sup>74</sup> applications are now out to 2024 but there is a possibility to put steel plates in
- the bridge as a temporary bridge. Paula Gulla said she was offered a
- <sup>76</sup> suggestion of putting in a steel plate arch in the bridge to bide the Town some
- time and they are willing to meet with the Public Works Director. Selectman
- 78 Devine said this would be a good idea. Selectman Tombarello said there is
- <sup>79</sup> \$50,000.00 in the Capital Reserve Fund but they would need to raise
- 80 additional funds to fix it.
- 81
- 82 Selectman Goldman said it was in the paper and also an email he received
- 83 from Rob Collins asking if the BOS would meet with the Feasibility &
- 84 Withdrawal Study Committee because they believe they have a very
- 85 preliminary buyout number. Selectman Goldman said he has no interest in
- 86 meeting with them until the project is completed. Selectwoman Buco said the
- 87 thinks why the Committee asked for the meeting was to let the BOS know that
- they have a preliminary figure and wanted the Board's opinion as to whether
- or not they should continue with the study. Selectwoman Buco said the BOS
- don't have the authority to ask the Committee to stop the study as this was a
- 91 warrant article that passed by the District and feels the study should be
- 92 completed. Selectman Goldman said when the study is complete he would be
- 93 willing to meet with the Committee. Selectman Devine asked Paula to let the
- School Board know they are not willing to meet at this time.

Selectman Tombarello said he was contacted by the Chief Electrical Inspector
 in regards to new LED lights being installed at Sandown North and he spoke to

the school's electrician and the superintendent as well letting them know the

school needs permits to do such work. He said that the superintendent said

100 he didn't think the schools needed to have permits and Selectman Tombarello

- said in 2007 the district was notified that they need to have permits when
  doing electrical work on the buildings. Selectman Tombarello referrers to
- information in the packet which shows several projects that have taken place
- in Sandown Central School and Sandown North. He said he would like to
- develop a yearly permit for Sandown and the District similar to the one in the
- packet for MASS. The cost of the permit is \$250.00 and is good for a 1 year
- span and will cover any electrical work done on any buildings/grounds within

- the District. Selectman Tombarello said the District will notify the Town of
- 109 Sandown quarterly so they can go into the buildings to see what is being
- updated. He also said there are no chairs, tables, etc at Sandown Central at
- 111 this point. Selectman Buco said she received an email stating the
- superintendent is moving forward with the plan of housing TLC and
- 113 Kindergarten at Sandown Central School.
