Selectman Devine asked the Board how they wanted to proceed. Selectman Goldman said he was disappointed in the judge for hearing the case then taking a week off without making a decision. Lynne suggested asking the Town attorney if he thinks we will win the case and also Danville needs to be contacted to see if they want to continue with the case. Selectwoman Buco said that he had a follow up meeting with Kim and the attorney and they talked about this situation. She feels that the judge not getting the right amount of information is a failure on the attorney as she supplied more than enough information to make their case. She also said the town can send a disk with all of the vimeo recordings of all of the meetings and what the public was told multiple times at public meetings and the deliberative session. Selectwoman Buco said the judge dodged making a judgement on the 91A and if the Town wins that part of the case then Town's legal fees will be paid. Selectman Goldman said that is a statewide big deal and that could become the new norm. Selectwoman Buco said that the Town of Danville is meeting as well to see if they are willing to move forward and Kim said she feels they will

33 continue. She also said the attorney said the cost will be \$2,500 - \$5,000 and
34 feels they should address the standings and reconsideration of all.
35 Selectwoman Buco feels the judge should have also made a decision on the
36 Right to Know law as well. Selectman Devine feels that all questions should be
37 appealed and is not happy with the judge either. Lynne Blaisdell feels a
38 supplemental memorandum should be sent as well. The consensus of the
39 Board is to move forward with the appeal. Selectwoman Buco will meet with
40 Kim from Danville and the attorney again and will forward the information to
41 the Board. Selectman Goldman is concerned because both attorneys had a
42 conversation prior to hearing the case.
