- make up the difference. He said included in the grant was \$20,000 for
- trainings, emergency vehicle operations and aerial ladder operations. He said
- after discussing this with the engineers they would like to move forward as
- they have the funds to make up the difference. He said they will be putting off
- the purchase of the ambulance until next year as he will need to take out
- \$260,000.00 to make up the difference. He said there will continue to be a
- warrant article each year to help purchase different vehicles.

- when it would be in service and Chief Tapley said it takes about a year to build
