84 there was going to be an interruption in service. Selectman Tombarello said the fire chief is
85 not in favor of this nor is the public works director nor is the Police Chief. Selectman
86 Devine said the district is a separate political entity and they have rules they have to follow.
87 Selectman feels like they should rely on the Chief Police of the town and he backs what the
88 Chief feels is better for the Town. Selectwoman Buco, Selectman Goldman and Selectman
89 Treanor all support the decision of the Police Chief, Fire Chief and Public Works Director.
