14	Meeting was called to order by Chair Mindy Salomone-Abood at 6:30 PM.
15	
16	Mindy Salomone-Abood asked the Committee to review the minutes of Wednesday,
17	August 10, 2011
18	Mindy Salomone-Abood stated that the minutes dated July 11 th should have been
19	changed to July 13 th . This change was made at the August 10 th meeting but the minutes
20	didn't reflect the change. Selectwoman Copp said lines 18 & 19 should read
21	Performance Base Budget. Bruce Cleveland said line 92 should read level funding by
22	reducingCathy Gorman said line 35 and line 36 should read Budget Committee
23	make their decisions and that the forms were not associated with performance based
24	budgeting and it was not discussed.
25	Motion by Selectwoman Copp to accept the minutes of Wednesday, September 7, 2011
26	be accepted as amended.
27	Seconded by Bruce Cleveland.
28	In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
29	Salomone-Abood and Ralph Millard.

31 Mindy Salomone-Abood stated that the Moderator is out of town and requested to come

32 in on September 14th at a later time. It was the consensus of the Committee to have the

33 Moderator come in on September 14th at 7:50.

34 (Robert Millard arrived 6:40)

35 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Assessing Account budget 4150.3 on the

36 *table for discussion*.

37 Second by Selectwoman Copp.

38 Selectwoman Copp explained that most of the budget is contractual. She said that

39 Visions is an annual maintenance fee, which allows residents to go online and update

40 their information. Dawn asked what the difference is between the Annual Maintenance

41 and the Website Maintenance. Mindy Salomone-Abood said that in the information

42 packet there is an agreement with Vision. It explains that the Website Maintenance

43 allows the values of the property to be updated and allows residents to have access to the

44 records. The Annual Maintenance is the software maintenance such as licensing fees,

45 etc. Bruce Cleveland asked if the names on the budget can be changed to match the

46 contract information. Mindy said she will mention it to Darlene and see if it can be

47 changed. Ralph Millard asked how much it would cost to do a full assessment and

48 Selectwoman Copp said it would cost about \$150,000.00 - \$200,000.00.

49 *Motion by* Mindy Salomone-Abood to accept the Assessing Account Budget with Gross

50 Expenses of \$81,800.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$81,800.00 pending

51 further review.

52 *Second by* Selectwoman Copp.

53 *In Favor*, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy

54 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.

55 Motion passes unanimously

57 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Patriotic Purposes Account budget

58 **4583.0** on the table for discussion.

59 Second by Selectwoman Copp.

60 Mindy explains that this is for the fireworks for Old Home Days and for wreaths for

Town buildings. Cathy Gorman asked if there was \$4,500.00 budgeted how come only

- 62 \$4,000.00 was used. Selectman Copp explained that bid was lower than expected and the
- 63 remainder of the money will go back into the General Fund. Bruce Cleveland asked
- 64 about the \$1.00 on the Revenue Account and Selectwoman Copp said it is there to hold
- 65 the line so donations can be accepted if they come in.
- 66 *Motion by* Mindy Salomone-Abood to accept the Patriotic Purposes Account Budget
- 67 with Gross Expenses of \$4,600.00, Revenue of \$1.00 and Net Expenses of \$4,500.00
- 68 pending further review.
- 69 *Second by* Selectwoman Copp.
- 70 In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
- 71 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 72 Motion passes unanimously
- 73

74 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Debt Exp-Principal Account budget

- 75 4711.0 on the table for discussion.
- 76 Second by Bruce Cleveland.
- 77 Mindy Salomone-Abood said there is budget worksheet for this account. This is to pay
- the principal amount of the loan for the Minton property purchased by the Town a few
- 79 years ago. Selectwoman Copp explains this is property that the Town purchased the
- 80 Minton property, now known as the Town Forest.
- 81 *Motion by* Selectwoman Copp to accept the Debt Exp-Principal Account Budget with
- 82 Gross Expenses of \$50,000.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$50,000.00
- 83 pending further review.
- 84 *Second by* Mindy Salomone-Abood.
- 85 In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
- 86 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 87 Motion passes unanimously
- 88
- 89 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Debt Exp-Interest Account budget 4721.0
- 90 on the table for discussion.
- 91 Second by Bruce Cleveland.
- 92 Mindy Salomone-Abood explains this is the interest on the Minton Property.

- 93 *Motion by* Selectwoman Copp to accept the Debt Exp-Interest Account budget with
- Gross Expenses of \$39,025.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$39,025.00
- 95 pending further review.
- 96 Second by Mindy Salomone-Abood.
- 97 In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
- 98 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 99 Motion passes unanimously
- 100
- 101 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Tan Note Account budget 4723.0 on the
- 102 *table for discussion*.
- 103 Second by Selectwoman Copp.

104 Selectwoman Copp explains this is put in the budget in case the Town needs to borrow 105 money at the end of the year if the tax rate for the following year has not been set. This is 106 strictly for interest to be paid on such loan. She said in the past it has been at \$10,500.00 107 but because of the interest rates going down the BOS feel that \$8,000.00 will be enough. 108 Selectwoman Copp said that the BOS asked if this can be held in a separate account in 109 case it is not used. The answer was no, it has to go be appropriated every year and if it is 110 not used it goes back into the General Fund. Mindy Salomone-Abood said it is used to 111 reduce taxes for the following year or can be used to last minute repairs at the end of the 112 year. Cathy Gorman asked who authorizes how the money in the General Fund is used at 113 the end of the year. Mindy said it is up to the BOS. Selectwoman Copp said most of the 114 money is used to offset taxes for the following year. She also explains the money can be 115 encumbered for the following year as long as there is a contract in place. Also if there is 116 an emergency that something needs to be fixed the BOS have the authority to use the 117 money from the General Fund to repair it. Bruce Cleveland asked if Selectwoman Copp 118 knew how much money is usually left in the General Fund at the end of the year. 119 Selectwoman Copp said it would vary from year to year but Darlene would have the 120 information from year 2010 and previous. Bruce said he would be interested in tracking 121 that for this year. Brenda also said that if a department went over their budget it would 122 be the Selectmen's responsibility to find the money to help that department. Cathy 123 Gorman doesn't understand if the Budget Committee approves budgets for department

- heads to work with how they can go over it. Selectwoman Copp explained that if
- 125 liaison's keep a close eye on department's budgets as do the department heads and if
- 126 there is some reason they are going to go over budget they need to get prior approval
- 127 from the BOS before they actually do go over. Selectman Copp said it is up to the BOS
- 128 to find the money for that department but it doesn't happen very often.
- 129 *Motion by* Mindy Salomone-Abood to accept the Tan Note Account budget with Gross
- 130 Expenses of \$8,000.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$8,000.00 pending further
- 131 review.
- 132 Second by Selectwoman Copp.
- 133 In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
- 134 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 135 Motion passes unanimously
- 136
- 137 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Street Light Account budget 4316.0 on
- 138 *the table for discussion.*
- 139 Second by Selectwoman Copp.

140 Mindy Salomone-Abood said there is a budget worksheet with this account. Mindy 141 stated under the significant budget changes, it is noted that in 2009 in was discovered that 142 the Town was being charged for more street lights than they actually have. Bruce 143 Cleveland compliments the committee for filling out the worksheet as it had a great deal 144 of information on it for the Budget Committee. Cathy Gorman called a point of 145 information as she would like to know the amount of the credit that was given to compare 146 the amounts budgeted in 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011. Bruce stated that according to the 147 work of the Local Energy Committee the \$4,000.00 amount looks reasonable. Mindy 148 Salomone-Abood said this budget it tabled until the information requested is provided. 149 150 Mindy Salomone-Abood asked the Budget Committee to review their budget as she 151 needs to present it to the BOS next week. The Committee worked on the budget 152 worksheet. The Committee voted on the Mission Statement to read: To present an annual

- 153 budget to the voters that ensures the financial operation of the Town while also
- 154 considering the economic burden of the Taxpayer. The Budget Committee is an official

- 155 committee operating under NH RSA Chapter 32 Municipal Budget Law. Under Primary
- 156 Services and Responsibilities the Board agreed that 1. Would be to present an annual
- 157 budget to the voters, 2. To ensure the Town has adequate funding to provide services to

158 its residents. Under Fiscal Year Objectives the Board agreed that 1. Would be to Present

- a level funded budget to voters, 2. Increase communication through budget worksheet
- and added column on request spreadsheets and 3. To hold adequate number of meetings
- 161 to reach our objectives.
- 162 Mindy Salomone-Abood explains how she came up with the amount for the Recording
- 163 Secretary, which was 18 meetings at 7.5 hours for meeting and transcription and also the

164 final public meeting of 15 hours. This would be a total of \$2,497.50 so she rounded it up

to \$2,500.00. She stated that in 2009 only 91% of the budget was used and in 2010 only

166 50% of the budget was used as the meetings were really short last year.

167 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to reduce the Recording Secretary line to \$2,300.00.

- 168 Second by Robert Millard.
- 169 Selectwoman Copp said she will not be voting on this motion, but reminds the Budget

170 Committee that how they vote on this will set precedence for all other budgets. Cathy

171 Gorham said that she would like to see what the total impact is on the taxes if all

- 172 employees received a 2% raise. Selectwoman Copp said that she did request that
- 173 information from Darlene, but she was not able to have it for this week but she plans on
- 174 having it for next week's meeting. Mindy Salomone-Abood stated that the raises are for
- all regular employees and not for stipend employees and was approved by the BOS. She
- also said the raises are merit raises not COLA and recording secretaries don't have
- 177 performance reviews. Cathy Gorham stated that she is not in favor or against anyone
- 178 getting a raise depending on their performance, she simply wants to see the total impact
- 179 before she makes a final decision.
- 180 *In Favor* Selectwoman Copp, Dawn Nicolaisen, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 181 *Opposed* Mindy Salomone-Abood and Cathy Gorham.
- 182 Abstain Selectwoman Copp.
- 183 Motion passes 4-1-2
- 184 Mindy explains the Supply line is usually very little except for this year as they bought a
- 185 new digital recorder for the recording secretary. The Committee agreed to leave the

- 186 Seminars at \$80.00. Ralph Millard talked about level funding budgets and not including187 pay raises.
- 188 The total for the Budget Committee budget is \$2,480.00 and the consensus of the
- 189 Committee is to present this amount to the BOS.
- 190

191 Motion by Mindy Salomone-Abood to put the Election & Registration Account budget

- 192 4140.2 on the table for discussion.
- 193 Second by Selectwoman Copp.
- 194 This budget is being presented by Rosemary Bruno and Diane Thompson. Rosemary
- said there will be 3 elections in 2012. Mindy Salomone-Abood asked about the Software
- 196 line and Rosemary explained it was for anti-virus software for the laptop they use for the
- 197 voter registrations. Cathy Gorham asked what the Copies and Manpower is and why it's
- 198 not being used and Rosemary said it is for training and mileage if it comes up. She also
- said she has asked several times for the line titles to be changed to read Training/Mileage.
- 200 *Motion by* Mindy Salomone-Abood to accept the Election & Registration Account
- 201 budget with Gross Expenses of \$3,725.00, Revenue of \$50.00 and Net Expenses of
- 202 \$3,675.00 pending further review.
- 203 Second by Selectwoman Copp.
- 204 In Favor, Bruce Cleveland, Selectperson Copp, Cathy Gorman, Dawn Nicolaisen, Mindy
- 205 Salomone-Abood, Ralph Millard and Robert Millard.
- 206 Motion passes unanimously
- 207 Dawn Nicolaisen asked how this account received revenue and Rosemary said it was by
- 208 selling voting lists at \$25.00 each.
- 209
- 210 Mindy Salomone-Abood stated there are 2 members of the Budget Committee attending
- 211 the NH LGC Budget Workshop. She told the committee members to get their
- 212 information to Lynne so she can register them.
- 213
- 214 Cathy Gorham asked how the Cable Board was coming with residents with satellite
- 215 receiving the meetings. Selectman Copp said the Chris Donnelan is still looking into it.
- 216

- 217 Mindy Salomone-Abood listed the budgets that will be discussed next week and asked
- the Committee if they needed any other additional information. The Committee was
- 219 good with the information they have.
- 220
