Bruce Cleveland said this is invaluable if you don't know the neighborhood and also said that putting the number on the house doesn't do any good if there is a 1,000 ft driveway. Dawn Nicolaisen said this is to purchase but not to install so how will people put it up if they can't afford to. She said this is a great idea but she'd like to know how it will be enforced. Hans said they will be placed 5 feet off the road and he also said there is a new ordinance in the works. Robert Millard said he would not like something like this in his yard, he said he already has a reflective sign on his house.

1104	exemption and they are just trying to make it comparable to the other Town's in the

1106	provides a generous exemption for them and the rest of the Town paid \$165,000.00 for
1107	the current exemption. She also feels that Sandown has the lowest amount of commercial
1108	industry to help with the taxes. She said he is going to send a letter to the BOS to ask that
1109	when there is petitioned warrant article that they include the petitioner's name so that if
1110	anyone has questions they know who to address the questions to. Selectman Devine said
1111	he didn't vote in favor of this because there are too many variables in the article. Robert

1112	Millard said there is a pretty small amount of elderly people in Town that would actually
1113	qualify for this and he believes it's the seniors that need the help. He also feels that the
1114	seniors would benefit more from this exemption than the events held at the recreation
1115	building for them.
