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15	Meeting was called to order by Bruce Cleveland at 6:30 PM.
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17	Bruce Cleveland asked the Committee to review the minutes of Wednesday, October 10,
18	2012. Bruce Cleveland stated that line 155 the Gross amount should be \$1,570.32.
19	Dawn Nicolaisen stated that line 106 should be LGC and not LCG.
20	Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the minutes of Wednesday, October 10, 2012 as

31 Artie Genualdo stated that the budget is up a bit from last year but there are no major 32 increases. He stated that he tries to ask for what is needed but no extras. Bruce 33 Cleveland asked about the cost of the Heating Oil line and asked Artie about the 34 installation of the waste oil furnace. Artie said that he has the furnace and he plans to 35 have it installed within a month, as soon as the building is ready. He said he is will run 36 the furnace during the day but keep the heat on at night. Artie also stated that he is 37 planning to disconnect the fax line as he doesn't use it enough and use the one at the 38 Town Hall. He said there should be a decrease in that line but he is not sure how much. 39 Cathy Gorman just arrived. 40 Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the Highway Facility Account with Gross Expenses of 41 \$10,156.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$10,156.00 pending further review. 42 **Seconded by** Jon Goldman. 43 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 44 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 45 Motion passes unanimously. 46 47 48 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Highway Operating Account budget 4312.0 on 49 the table for discussion. 50 Seconded by Brenda Copp. 51 Artie Genualdo is presenting this budget. Dawn Nicolasien questioned the Equipment 52 Purchase line and asked why it is only at 36% and Artie stated he hasn't had a chance to 53 purchase the items needed yet. He said most of his time has been spent on the road 54 repairs and they are almost completed so he will be ordering soon. Bruce Cleveland 55 asked what Artie would be ordering and he said rakes, shovels, lawn equipment, etc. 56 Dawn also asked if the Sand and Salt lines weren't used much because of the mild winter 57 last year and Artie said yes. Artie also said that whatever money is left in the Sand, Salt 58 and Plowing lines will be put into the Plowing Expendable Trust Fund. Artie said he is 59 not putting in a warrant article this year to add more money to the Trust Fund as he feels 60 what will be left in the budget will be sufficient for this year. Bruce Cleveland asked 61 how this will be reflected in the budget next year and Brenda Copp said it will be in the

62 Town Report. Bruce asked about the use of the molasses in the salt. Artie said he is not 63 using as much salt by using the molasses in it and he usually orders 1,400 tons each year. 64 Lauren Cairns asked about the Office Details line as it is way over budget this year. Artie 65 said he needs an officer when they work on the main roads in Town and doesn't feel he 66 will go over again. Artie said he will use some money from his Block Grant to pay for 67 the overages in his budget. Dawn Nicolasien asked why the Vehicle Maintenance line is 68 so low and Artie said he retired a truck this year and he is looking to purchasing a new 69 truck instead of repairing it. Artie said he is looking for a pick up for his use and not a 70 dump truck. He said the BOS are supporting the Warrant Article and asked for the 71 Budget Committee's support as well. 72 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to accept the Highway Operating Account with Gross Expenses 73 of \$517,077.16, Revenue of \$350.00 and Net Expenses of \$156,727.16 pending further 74 review. 75 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen. 76 Bruce Cleveland asked what the Revenue is from and Artie said it is from the driveway 77 permits. 78 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 79 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 80 Motion passes unanimously. 81 82 83 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Sanitation Facility Account budget 4321.0 on the 84 table for discussion. 85 Seconded by Brenda Copp. 86 Artie Genualdo is presenting this budget. Bruce Cleveland asked about the Electricity 87 line and stated that it has gone up over \$1,000.00 and said that the breakdown comes out 88 to \$136.00 wk for 15 hours of operation. Bruce asked if there was a plan to reduce this 89 and Artie said he spoke to Ryan from the Local Energy Commission and told him he'd

152	there was also a change in the Deliberative Session line. Bruce asked the Committee if
153	anyone had any questions about the numbers that need to change.

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154 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to change the Deputy Clerk line to \$24,057.35. 155 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen. 156 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 157 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 158 Motion passes unanimously. 159 160 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to change the Municipal Clerk line to \$19,738.94. 161 Seconded by Lauren Cairns. 162 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 163 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 164 Motion passes unanimously. 165 166 *Motion by Brenda Copp to increase the Deliberative Session line to \$257.10.* 167 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen. 168 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 169 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 170 Motion passes unanimously. 171 172 Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the Town Clerk Account with Gross Expenses of 173 \$49,024.05, Revenue of \$934,974.38 and Net Expenses of -\$885,950.33 pending further 174 review. 175 Seconded by Lauren Cairns. 176 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 177 Copp, Bill Carter, Cathy Gorman. 178 Motion passes unanimously. 179 180 181 Brenda Copp stated that the Committee approved the Assessing Account the first week of 182 budgets and this year they need to a statistical revaluation by law so a line needs to be 183 added to this budget in the amount of \$38,400.00. She said the BOS received 3 quotes to 184 do the revaluation and will bring them to the next Budget Committee meeting so the

185	Board can review them. This will be on the November 7 th agenda. Jon asked for the
186	P&L for the past few years as well.
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188	Bruce Cleveland said that there won't be a meeting next week and the following meeting
189	will be on November 7 th and the budgets that will be discussed will be the Insurance
190	Account, Gov't Building and Executive Budget. Brenda said the BOS are waiting for
191	quotes on the Executive budget and Gov't Building budget. Brenda said she will ask the
192	office to have copies ready as soon as they can on these 2 budgets and the Committee
193	will be notified when they are ready to be picked up. Bruce also stated he will send out
194	the information electronically as well. Jon asked if the committee can get a copy of the
195	entire budget, P&L and all paperwork that goes with that budget. Bruce said he will
196	check with the office to see if that is possible.
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198	Brenda Copp reminded the public to vote on November 6 th in the Presidential Election.
