14	Meeting was called to order by Bruce Cleveland at 6:30 PM.
15	
16	Bruce Cleveland asked the Committee to review the minutes of Wednesday, December 5,
17	2012. Bruce stated that line 43 the Revenue should be \$500.00 and the Gross Expenses
18	should be \$14,751.00. Bruce also stated the budget numbers were left off of line 51
19	Health & Human Services should be 4415.0, line 72 the Benefits account number should
20	be 4155.0 and line 151 the Government Building account should be 4194.0.
21	Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the minutes of Wednesday, December 5, 2012 as
22	amended.

29	Bruce Cleveland states that the Highway budget will have some changes in it as he
30	received a letter from Lynne in regards to the house numbering system. Bruce explains

31 that there are 36 houses that still need house numbers and the Highway Department will

32 be responsible to putting up the numbers. There will also be fines assessed if the

33 residents don't comply so there will also be an increase in the Revenue line as well for

34 this account. Bruce said this will be brought up again at the final budget hearing to

35 change the numbers.

37 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Recreation Operations Account budget 4520.2 38 on the table for discussion.

40 Presenting this budget are Ron Dulong, Deb Brown, George Blaisdell and Mike

41 Donovan.

42 Deb Brown handed out new P&L's to the Committee. Deb also explained to the Board

43 what it is that Recreation does. She said they are a committee that oversees 21 acres of

44 maintained recreation area such as ball fields, recreation building and playgrounds. She

45 stated they also run programs for adults, children and seniors. They also collaborate with

46 other towns on certain activities as well. Deb also states they have 3 accounts so the

47 numbers are more transparent. Bruce Cleveland asked why the Building Maintenance

48 line is up from \$300.00 to \$1,300.00 and Ron Dulong said that the Recreation building is

49 three years old and the interior needs to be repaired and painted.

51 Expenses of \$16,767.00, Revenue of \$3,495.00 and Net Expenses of \$13,272.00 pending

52 further review.

62 Presenting this budget are Ron Dulong, Deb Brown, George Blaisdell and Mike63 Donovan.

64 Bruce Cleveland asked why the Payroll line went up by \$8,000.00. Deb Brown 65 explained they used to offer a program from 9am - 3pm and they also offer before and 66 after care. Because they have a significant number of residents that use both the before 67 and after care they decided to expand the program to 8am - 4pm and therefore they 68 increased the hours for the counselors as well. She also said they projected the Revenue 69 to be \$37,885.00 and it was actually \$48,606.00, which is an increase of 128%. Dawn 70 Nicolaisen asked how many employees there are and Ron Dulong said there are 13 71 regular counselors and 1 part time counselor and last year there were 11 full time 72 counselors. Ron said there is a total of 17 employees with the coordinator and assistant 73 coordinator. Bruce Cleveland asked about the number of employees vs. the amount they 74 are being paid and Deb said they have the same number of employees but they have some 75 employees that have left and they need to hire new employees at a lower rate. Brenda 76 Copp stated this budget looks like an increase of 18% but with the amount of Revenue 77 coming in it is actually a decrease of 10.16%. Jon Goldman said it is a great program for 78 less than \$1,000.00 per week and it keeps the kids busy and off the streets. 79 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to accept the Park & Recreation Account budget (Summer 80 Recreation and Special Programs) with Gross Expenses of \$61,449.08, Revenue from 81 Summer Recreation of \$48,606.00, and Revenue from Special Programs of \$4,057.00 and 82 Net Expenses of \$8,786.08 pending further review. 83 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen 84 In Favor, Dawn Nicolaisen, Lauren Cairns, Jon Goldman, Bruce Cleveland, Brenda 85 Copp, Bill Carter and Cathy Gorman. 86 Motion passes unanimously 87 88 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Parks & Recreation Account budget 4520.0 on 89 the tale for discussion. 90 Seconded by Brenda Copp.

- 91 Presenting this budget are Ron Dulong, Deb Brown, George Blaisdell and Mike
- 92 Donovan. Deb Brown thanks the Budget Committee for allowing the Recreation

93 Commission to come in last as a lot of the responsibility has to do without door facilities 94 and they wait until the end of the year to spend the money needed. Deb Brown reminded 95 the Committee that last winter was very mild and the fields were being used in the 96 beginning of April, which is pretty early. Bruce Cleveland said that they would like to 97 have the Benefits account be on the last week and have Recreation be on the second to 98 last week. Deb said that would not be a problem as long as the Budget Committee 99 understands that they are still spending money at that time. Jon Goldman asked about the 100 Ball Field/Playground line as only 50% of the budget has been used at this time. Deb 101 explained that the Mowing line was over expended by \$1,300.00 because the mowing 102 began in April and they had to pay for 4 additional mowing that year. She also stated 103 they put off the irrigating of the field because they didn't have the money for it and she 104 also stated that \$1,300.00 will come out of the Ball Field /Playground line to cover the 105 overage on the Mowing line. She also said there is maintenance going on now which will 106 deplete the line by another \$1,200.00. Jon Goldman also asked about the Beach line as it 107 is at 55% and Deb said there is maintenance being done there this week which will cost 108 between \$350.00 & \$450.00. Jon then asked about the Community Program line not 109 being used and Deb explained that they just spoke to the BOS in regards to this line and 110 the money has been allocated as a community project for a new piece of playground 111 equipment. She said they usually hold a community event in the nicer weather but 112 because of the increase in the summer program she didn't have the time to plan a 113 community activity. Bruce Cleveland asked what the \$1,900.00 will be used for under 114 the New Equipment line. Deb said they are planning to purchase a commercial grade 115 structure for shade and they cost \$785.00 plus shipping. The remainder will be used for 116 playground equipment at the recreation building. Dawn Nicolaisen said she understands 117 the need to wait until the end of the year to purchase new equipment as they are usually 118 on sale and you can get last year's model. Dawn also asked about the increase in the 119 Recording Secretary line and Deb explained that up until 2010 they budgeted for 12 120 meetings per year and now they meet twice per month and in 2011 and 2012 the 121 recreation commission met 19 times and she said if they didn't have a recording secretary 122 they she transcribed the minutes and was paid from the Recreation Director's payroll line

123	and it was not paid from the Recording Secretary line. They are allotting 6 hours per
124	meeting for the meeting and transcription.
125	Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the Parks and Recreation budget with Gross Expenses
126	of \$85,477.41, Revenue of \$1.00 and Net Expenses of \$85,476.41 pending further
127	review.

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134	Bruce Cleveland stated the Final Public Hearing will be at 6:30pm on January 11 th with

140	Brenda Copp explains the information reflects the new rates of the permit fees. Brenda
141	said the new building inspector called area towns to inquire about their rates and she said
142	that the Town of Sandown was very low compared to the area towns. She said she took
143	the amount of permits for this year and added a few more through the end of the year and
144	the new rate Payroll line should have been \$21,000.00 but she felt the amount of
145	\$12,500.00 would be sufficient as it is fee based. Brenda also said the telephone went up
146	because the previous building inspector held 5 positions and now there is just 1 inspector
147	with his own phone line.

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196	Brenda Copp mentioned that the BOS decided to remove the copier from the budget this
197	year and they will only have the maintenance for the current copier and they will revisit
198	this again next year.

200	Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Library Account budget 4550.0 on the table for
201	discussion.
202	Seconded by Brenda Copp.
203	Brenda Copp explained that the Benefits line needs to be increased by \$1,566.00 as the
204	librarian receives benefits from the town and the increase was from \$1,000.00 to
205	\$1,5000.00 per person and Dawn Nicolaisen asked if the \$1,000.00 was already in the
206	budget and Brenda said she does not know for sure. The Budget Committee feels the
207	discussion on this budget should wait until the Final Public Hearing.
208	
209	Brenda Copp stated that at this point the total budget increase from last year is increased
210	by 4.22%. Bruce explains that he would like to educate the public that even though the
211	Gross Expenses went up the Revenue also went up. Jon suggested including it in the
212	packet for Deliberative Session. Cathy Gorman suggested to hand out the information on
213	Election Day as there is not a big turnout for deliberative session. Bill Carter said it is
214	not known of the tax base increase. He also asked about the Warrant Article for the
215	Police Station and asked to look at the overall Town impact. Dawn Nicolaisen said there

216 is a good Town Budget with responsible department heads and the residents of the Town

217 need to get more involved in the School Budget if they are concerned about their taxes

218 going up.

- 226 Committee has more accurate figures as to how much of the line was actually used this
- 227 year. Dawn Nicolaisen agrees to fund it but not at 100%. Jon Goldman said it is
- currently funded at 69%.
