14	The meeting was called to order by Bruce Cleveland at 6:30 PM.
15	
16	Bruce Cleveland asked the Committee to review the minutes of Wednesday, September
17	11, 2013.
18	Brenda Copp stated line 5 should read Wednesday, not Thursday. She also stated that all
19	of the motions that were made on the budgets should have passed unanimously with a
20	vote of 5-0-0 not 5-0-1. Brenda also stated that on lines 191 – 196 the budget that was
21	being discussed (Election & Registration, supervisors) was reduced without an
22	explanation as to why. Let it be noted that the Supervisors stipend was reduced from
23	\$1,100.00 per person was reduced to \$1,000.00 per person as the original budget
24	presented had the incorrect amount. Dawn Nicolaisen said line 191 should read Joanne
25	Vey.
26	Bruce Cleveland said the minutes were accepted as amended.
27	
28	Bruce Cleveland said there still hasn't been any interest in the open position on the
29	Board. Interested parties should let the BOS know.

- 31 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Budget Committee budget 4150.9 on the table for
- 32 discussion.
- 33 Seconded by DawnNicolaisen.
- 34 The Committee suggested reducing the Payroll line as it is not all being used. The
- estimate was 13 meetings x 2.5 hours per meetings with 5 hours of transcription for a
- total of 108 hours x\$17.32 per hour is \$1,870.00. The consensus of the Board is to
- change the Payroll line to \$2,000.00.
- 38 Brenda Copp cautioned the Committee not to cut the budget too much as a few years ago
- 39 she had to go before the BOS to ask for more money in the budget as they went over on
- 40 the Payroll line. She said it is better to have a little extra in the budget. Steve Brown
- suggested to reduce the Supplies line to \$1.00 as this line is not being used. The Board
- 42 agrees to keep the Seminars line at \$240.00. The total budget that will be presented is a
- 43 total of \$2,241.00.
- 44 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to increase the rate of pay for the Recording Secretary, Sue
- 45 Reynolds by 2%.
- 46 **Seconded by** Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 47 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 48 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 49 Motion passes unanimously.

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- 51 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Building Inspector Account budget 4241.2 on
- 52 the table for discussion.
- 53 Seconded by Steve Brown.
- Bob Bogosh is presenting this budget.
- 55 Motion by Steve Brown to accept the Building Inspector budget with Gross Expenses of
- \$14,030.00, Revenue of \$17,000.00 and Net Expenses of -\$2,970.00 pending further
- 57 review.
- 58 **Seconded by** Cathy Gorman.
- 59 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 60 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 61 *Motion passes unanimously.*

- 62 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Code Enforcement Account budget 4241.3 on
- 63 the table for discussion.
- 64 Seconded by Steve Brown.
- Bob Bogosh is presenting this budget. Bob explained that this is for violations to permits
- or working with the Health Inspector for home inspections. He states this is a stipend
- position. Brenda Copp explained that at the BOS meeting it was discussed that for the
- 68 Code Enforcement budget the fines may be Revenue for this budget so it can be tracked
- better for the future.
- 70 Motion by Steve Brown to accept the Code Enforcement budget with Gross Expenses of
- \$3,567.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$3,567.00 pending further review.
- 72 **Seconded by** Brenda Copp.
- 73 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 74 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 75 Motion passes unanimously.
- 77 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Health Officer Account budget 4411.0 on the
- 78 table for discussion.

- 79 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 80 Ed Mencis is presenting this budget. Ed stated that at the BOS meeting the question
- came up as to why there was no money being used for water testing. Ed said he went
- over it with the bookkeeper and they are all paid. He stated there were several tests at the
- library that he doesn't foresee next year but he will be doing the Town buildings yearly.
- 84 Steve Brown asked about the Daycare Inspection line as it is not being used and Ed said
- 85 he did one daycare inspection last year. Brenda Copp said these are done by the state and
- if there is a problem then it is up to the Town to come in and inspect them, which is why
- 87 there is money in the budget for this. Steve Brown wanted to be sure that there is enough
- 88 money in the Seminars line and Ed said he thinks it should be ok as he attends a lot of
- 89 free ones as well. Brenda also noted that the BOS dropped the Payroll line by .16 as the
- 90 DRA asked to keep whole numbers in the Payroll line of the budget. The consensus of
- 91 the Board is to change the Payroll amount to \$3,566.00. Bruce Cleveland said he likes
- 92 this idea and would like to see all budgets come in with whole numbers.

- 93 Motion by Brenda Copp to accept the Health Officer Account with Gross Expenses of
- \$3,967.00, Revenue of \$50.00 and Net Expenses of \$3,917.00 pending further review.
- 95 Seconded by Steve Brown.
- 96 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 97 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 98 Motion passes unanimously.

- 100 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Septic Account budget 4242.1 on the table for
- 101 discussion.
- 102 Seconded by Steve Brown.
- 103 Ed Mencis is presenting this budget. Ed stated this is a fee based budget. Ed also said he
- is keeping track of failed systems.
- 105 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to accept the Septic Account with Gross Expenses of \$2,900.00,
- Revenue of \$2,550 and Net Expenses of \$350.00 pending further review.
- 107 **Seconded by** Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 108 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 109 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.

- 112 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Electrical Inspector Account budget 4241.5 on
- 113 the table for discussion.
- 114 Seconded by Steve Brown.
- This is a fee based position. Steve Brown asked about the Supply line as only \$30.00 has
- been spent in the past 3 years. Brenda Copp stated that the previous inspector held 5
- positions and he was using the same inspection forms for all departments and now he will
- be purchasing his own Electrical Inspection forms.
- 119 *Motion by* Steve Brown to accept the Electrical Inspector Account with Gross Expenses
- of \$6,670.00, Revenue of \$8,000.00 and Net Expenses of -\$1,330.00 pending further
- 121 review.
- 122 **Seconded by** Dawn Nicolaisen.

123 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve 124 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen. 125 Motion passes unanimously. 126 127 There was a 10 minute break until 7:30. 128 129 Bruce Cleveland stated he left messages for members of the Conservation Commission in 130 regards to tonight's meeting. 131 132 Motion by Bruce Cleveland to put the Conservation Commission Account budget 133 4619.0 on the table for discussion. 134 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen. Bruce Cleveland explains that the budget was on the agenda for 7:15 and it is now 7:30 135 136 and there is no representation for this budget. The Committee is in agreement that the 137 budget be discussed anyway. Brenda Copp said when the Conservation Commission 138 came before the BOS most of the budget was estimated. She said the feel they will have 139 more meetings and the will need to advertise more. Brenda said the Paul Carey came 140 before the BOS with this budget. Cathy asked if the Ad's and Education & Awareness 141 are requirements and Brenda said the biggest majority may be required but she doesn't 142 know for sure. Daniel Saltalamacchia asks why the Environmental Consultant line is 143 being increased when they haven't used what they have asked for in the past years. 144 Brenda explained that in years past they didn't have a full member Board so they weren't 145 able to have the necessary meetings. Now they have a complete Board. Steve Brown 146 said in regards to the Advertising line that public notices need to be put in the paper and 147 the Conservation Commission has no control over how many so he recommends to leave 148 that line at \$180.00 as requested. He did have a question in regards to the Conference 149 line as they have only used \$60.00 in the last 3 years and doesn't feel the \$150.00 is 150 necessary. 151 *Motion by* Steve Brown to reduce the Conference line to \$100.00. 152 Seconded by Daniel Saltalamacchia.

- 154 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 155 Motion passes unanimously.
- 156 Cathy Gorman said in 2011 they used more than budgeted but in 2012 and 2013 they
- haven't used much of the amount budgeted. Steve Brown feels at this point they
- 158 Conservation Commission should know how much their dues are and feels that line
- should be reduced.
- 160 *Motion by* Steve Brown to reduce the Dues line to \$250.00.
- 161 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 162 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 163 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 164 Motion passes unanimously.
- Bruce Cleveland asked about the Environmental Consultant as in the past 3 years they
- haven't used more than 73% and they are asking for 23% more. Brenda Copp said they
- anticipated having to use the consultant more as they hope to have more meetings. Cathy
- Gorman asked if the consultant is required to be at all meetings and Dawn Nicolaisen
- didn't think so.
- 170 *Motion by* Dawn Nicolaisen to reduce the Environmental Consultant line to \$3,000.00
- based on previous usage and there is no representative here to explain why they need it.
- 172 Seconded by Daniel Saltalamacchia.
- 173 Cathy Gorman feels that \$3,000.00 is too much.
- 174 *In Favor*, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Bruce Cleveland, Steve Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 175 *Opposed*, Cathy Gorman.
- 176 Abstain, Brenda Copp
- 177 *Motion passes 4-1-1*
- 178 *Motion by* Cathy Gorman to reduce the Office Supply line to \$50.00 because they
- haven't been using what they have asked for in the past 3 years.
- 180 Seconded by Daniel Saltalamacchia.
- 181 In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Steve
- 182 Brown, Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 183 Motion passes unanimously.

- In regards to the Recording Secretary Cathy Gorman feels the amount requested is too
- high as again they aren't using what they are asking for. Brenda Copp said at the BOS
- meeting Paul Carey said they anticipate having 2 meetings a month, but he didn't give a
- time of the meeting or the amount of transcription. Dawn Nicolaisen feels the amount
- needs to be adjusted but she is not sure how. Brenda Copp also said the Recording
- 189 Secretary also has office hours as well.
- 190 *Motion by* Cathy Gorman to reduce the Recording Secretary line from \$2,678.00 to
- 191 \$1,750.00.
- 192 Seconded by Daniel Saltalamacchia.
- 193 Steve Brown said he is going to vote no on this motion as he feels it is not enough
- 194 *In Favor*, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia.
- 195 *Opposed*, Brenda Copp, Bruce Cleveland, Dawn Nicolaisen, Steve Brown.
- 196 *Motion failed 2-4-0*
- 197 *Motion by* Steve Brown to reduce the Recording Secretary line to \$2,000.00.
- 198 Seconded by Dawn Nicolaisen.
- 199 *In Favor*, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Bruce Cleveland, Steve Brown, Dawn
- 200 Nicolaisen.
- 201 Abstain, Brenda Copp.
- 202 *Motion passes 5-0-1*
- 203 Dawn Nicolaisen asked what the Education and Awareness line is used for. Steve Brown
- said it is used for the Fishing Derby and different events held in the Town Forest. Steve
- also said it would be nice to have someone here from the Conservation Commission to
- present the Budget Committee with paperwork as to what they are requesting the money
- for. Cathy Gorman said she would like them to stick to the budget they are requesting as
- some of the lines in the budget have gone over. Brenda Copp said because this is a
- bottom line budget they can use more of one line and less of another if needed. At this
- 210 time the entire budget is at 57% and it should be at 80%.
- 211 *Motion by* Steve Brown to accept the Conservation Commission budget with Gross
- 212 Expenses of \$7,437.00, Revenue of \$240.00 and Net Expenses of \$7,197.00 pending
- 213 further review.
- 214 Seconded by Daniel Saltalamacchia.

215	In Favor, Cathy Gorman, Daniel Saltalamacchia, Bruce Cleveland, Steve Brown, Dawn
216	Nicolaisen, Brenda Copp.
217	Motion passes unanimously
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219	Bruce Cleveland lists the budgets that will be reviewed next week.
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221	Steve Brown will not be at next week's meeting, and Bruce Cleveland said he probably
222	won't be at December 4 th meeting.
223	
224	Brenda Copp said the BOS set the date for Deliberative Session as February 1, 2014 and
225	there is no snow date. If the meeting isn't held on the 1st then it has to be held within 72
226	hours. She also asks the Committee to consider having the budgets come back to the
227	final meeting if they don't show up for their scheduled budget date. The consensus of the
228	Board is to have them come in on the final meeting date. Brenda also suggested that an
229	email go out to the department heads requesting proper paperwork and letting them know
230	when they are on the schedule. Steve Brown feels that if there is a specific reason
231	research needs to be done on a budget then they can come back at a different date,
232	otherwise they can come to the final budget meeting. Bruce said he will email the
233	department heads prior to their meeting dates to request proper documentation.
