- 48 to pay the Town Engineer. She also said as far as the Grant line of \$2,000.00, this was a
- 49 payment that was made to RPC for the Master Plan and they received \$4,000.00 worth of
- work. Brenda also stated this is the last year for the Master Plan so she is not sure if the
- 51 line should remain in the budget. Brenda stated that the breakdown of the Planning
- 52 Board/ZBA/Conservation Commission Aide for last week was as follows: 14 hours, 5 ½
- on Tuesday and Thursday was submitted for office hours, 2 hours on Monday for
- 54 Planning Bd minutes and 1 hours Conservation agenda and correspondence.

- to take the 2% pay increase and this year she only wanted to take a 1% increase. Brenda
- felt she would now be down 3% so the BOS voted to give her the 2% increase for this
- year. Bruce Cleveland asked about the increase of the Tax Lien Expenses line. Brenda
- 79 Copp said there have been more liens placed on properties, which creates more expenses
- 80 for the Town.
- 81 *Motion by* Brenda Copp to increase the Payroll line to \$49,364.00.
