15	Chairman Lee Dube called the meeting to order at 7:31pm.
16	
17	The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was done.
18	
19	Lee Dube asked the Board to review the minutes of Wednesday, September 16, 2015.
20	Lee stated line 59 should read if Lynne expected to expend and line 77 should be
21	\$67,040.00
22	Motion by Lee Dube to accept the minutes of Wednesday, September 16, 2015 as
23	amended.
24	Seconded by Tony Piemonte.
25	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
26	Motion passes unanimously.
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28	Lee Dube mentioned that there is still an opening on the Budget Committee for just 1
29	year and if there is anyone out there that is interested please submit a letter of interest to
30	the office.

- 32 The Building Inspector account 4241-20 was put on the table for discussion.
- 33 This budget is being presented by Bob Bogosh.
- 34 Bob said he reduced the Payroll line with the new system it seems to be rolling into the
- 35 next year. He said he increased the Seminars line and the Books line as he will need to
- 36 order new books next year due to the code changes. Tony Piemonte asked about the
- 37 decrease in the Telephone line and Bob said he uses the phone when he has to and feels
- 38 comfortable in reducing this line.
- 39 *Motion by* Tony Piemonte to accept the Building Inspector account with Gross Expenses
- 40 of \$11,240.00, Revenue of \$17,000.00 and Net Expenses of -\$5,760.00 pending further
- 41 review.
- 42 *Seconded by* Lee Dube.
- 43 *In Favor*, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
- 44 *Motion passes unanimously*.
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- 46 The Code Enforcement account 4241-21 was put on the table for discussion.
- 47 This budget is being presented by Bob Bogosh.
- 48 Bob said this budget is the same as last year.
- 49 *Motion by* Tony Piemont to accept the Code Enforcement budget with Gross Expenses of
- 50 \$3,650.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$3,650.00 pending further review.
- 51 *Seconded by* Lee Dube.
- 52 *In Favor*, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
- 53 Motion passes unanimously.

## 55 Electrical Inspector account 4241-25 was put on the table for discussion.

- 56 Tom Tombarello is presenting this budget.
- 57 Tom thanks Lee for announcing the Budget Committee opening as it is a very important58 position in the Town.
- 59 Tom said this is a permit fee based budget and \$35.00 goes towards the inspection and
- 60 \$20.00 goes towards the Town for administration fees. Tom said he reduced the Books
- 61 like to 1.00 for this year as there are no new books to purchase, but he will be asking for
- 62 an increase in that line for next year. Tom also explained that the Revenue line is a bit

63	higher as there have been residents in Town doing work without permits so there are
64	fines being paid. Tony Piemonte asked about the Payroll increase and Tom said he
65	increased it \$500.00 as inspections have been picking up and there some upcoming
66	developments in Town. Dean Wester asked about new construction and Tom said that
67	they are charged \$125.00 for 3 inspections, a surface inspection, a rough inspection and a
68	final inspection.
69	Motion by Tony Piemoonte to accept the Electrical Inspection budget with Gross
70	Expenses of \$6,951.00, Revenue of \$8,000.00 and Net Expenses of -\$1,049.00 pending
71	further review.
72	Seconded by Dean Webster
73	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
74	Motion passes unanimously.
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76	The Septic account 4242 was put on the table for discussion.
77	Ed Mencis is presenting this budget.
78	Ed said there is no change in this budget from last year. Dean Webster asked what the
79	Pumping line is for and Ed Mencis stated that in case they need to pump a tank they need
80	money in that line. Ed said to pump 1 tank it is now \$280.00 and this is something that
81	needs to be in the budget in case of an emergency, which is used to pump town property.
82	Michael Constanzo asked why there is \$110.17 in the 2014 budget and Tom Tombarello
83	said he believes this was a partial payment from a resident and the Town picked up the
84	balance. Tom also said the BOS have been talking about moving this to the Welfare
85	budget.
86	Motion by Tony Piemonte to accept the Septic account with Gross Expenses of
87	\$2,960.00, Revenue of \$3,500.00 and Net Expenses of -\$540.00 pending further review.
88	Seconded by Dean Webster.
89	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
90	Motion passes unanimously.
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92	The Health Officer account 4411 was put on the table for discussion.
93	Ed Mencis is presenting this budget.

94	Ed said there is no change in this budget. Tony Piemonte asked Ed how many seminars
95	he attends and Ed said about 4, but he tries to go to the free ones and will travel to
96	Concord. Ed said he has 1 or 2 more left for this year and feels comfortable with the
97	\$250.00 budgeted. Dean Webster asked about the Water Testing line and it being over
98	budget the past few years and wants to be sure there is enough money allotted for that.
99	Ed said that this depends on the amount the lab charges and he tries to stagger the Town
100	buildings every other year.
101	Motion by Tony Piemonte to accept the Health Officer budget with Gross Expenses of
102	\$4,167.00, Revenue of \$50.00 and Net Expenses of \$4,117.00 pending further reeiw.
103	Seconded by Dean Webster.
104	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
105	Motion passes unanimously.
106	
107	The Conservation Commission account 4619 was put on the table for discussion.
108	This budget is being presented by Brian Butler.
109	Brian said the budget pretty much stayed the same but there is an increase in the Dues
110	line as their dues increased from the State. Michael Constanzo asked aboaut the
111	Environmental Consultant line and why it has varied in the past 3 years. Brian explained
112	that last year they had no hire a new consultant and the previous one gave them a very big
113	discount. Brian said the new consultant is Bruce Gilday and he charges \$150.00 per
114	meeting as well as helps out with questions that are brought to the Conservation
115	Commission in regards to residents doing work on water front property. Brian said Bruce
116	also helps give advice to homeowners and Eagle Scout projects as well. Dean asked if
117	the Town is indemnified and Brian said no, but Bruce has his own insurance. Lee Dube
118	asked if there are permits that are pulled with the Conservation Commission and Brain
119	said yes and Brian will help to put the homeowner in the right direction. Dean Webster
120	asked what the protocol is to use the consultants services and Brian said a resident would
121	call Paul Carey, the Chairman of the Conservation Commission and if Paul feels it is
122	necessary then the consultant will be asked to help out. Brian said the bills are submitted
123	and the Chair of the Conservation Commission authorizes payment. Michael Constanzo
124	asked about the writing on the rock wall and Brian said there is not much they can do, he

125	said this is beyond his control. Michael Constanzo asked about the Ads line and Brian
126	said this line is used to advertise when there is land purchased.
127	Motion by Tony Piemonte to accept the Conservation Commission budget with Gross
128	Expenses of \$9,370.00, Revenue of \$240.00 and Net Expenses of \$9,130.00 pending
129	further review.
130	Seconded by Dean Webster.
131	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
132	Motion passes unanimously.
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134	Brian invited the public to the Spooky Walk to support the Boy Scouts.
135	
136	Lee Dube said the Budget Committee needs to set their budget and reviewed what he
137	thought it should be. Lee said the budget will be increased 22% over last year due to the
138	increase in the Recording Secretary line by 2%, an increase in the Seminars line from
139	\$240.00 to \$600.00, as there could very well be a brand new Budget Committee next year
140	and everyone will need to attend the budget seminar. Lee also said he increased the
141	Supply line from \$1.00 to \$100.00 as there may be need new binders to purchase for new
142	Committee members. Lee asked if the Committee was okay with this and they were.
143	Motion by Lee Dube to move the Budget Committee budget to the BOS with Gross
144	Expenses of \$2,667.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$2,667.00.
145	Seconded by Dean Webster.
146	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
147	Motion passes unanimously.
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149	Michael Constanzo stated that the NH Municipal Seminar was excellent and feels it
150	should be mandatory to attend.
151	
152	<i>Motion by</i> Tony Piemonte to adjourn.

154	In Favor, Lee Dube, Tony Piemnonte, Dean Webster and Michael Constanzo.
