15	Vice Chairman Cathy Gorman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

17	The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was done.
18	
19	The Police budget 4210 was put on the table for discussion.
20	This budget is being presented by Chief Gordon and Cheryl Eastman.
21	Cathy Gorman stated that the Payroll line is now lower that the first time the Committee
22	reviewed the budget. Cheryl said this has to do with the number of hours for part time
23	officers was reduced. She also said the Payroll has increased again because the Chief
24	took 2 part time positions and made it 1 full time position. The Payroll line is currently
25	\$444,623.00. Cathy Gorman asked what the Payroll line was previously and Cheryl said
26	it was \$439,828.00. Dean Webster asked about the increase in the Educational Incentive
27	line and Chief Gordon said the new full time officer gets a dollar more an hour because
28	he has a bachelor's degree, which is a contractual item.
29	Selectwoman Buco arrived at this time.

93	The Beneifts budget 4155 was put on the table for discussion.	
94	Cheryl Eastman is presenting this budget.	
95	Cheryl said this budget is a 13% increase due to the 1 part time position going to full	
96	time, which is the Recreation Director's position and because the Police Chief removed 2	
97	part time positions and created 1 full time position. Cheryl said in regards to the Health	
98	Insurance line there would have been a savings to the Town however there were 3	
99	employees previously on the health insurance plan that came back to the town's plan	
100	once the plan had changed. She said if the same amount of employees stayed on the p	
101	then there would have been a savings. Dean Webster asked how many employees are on	
102	the plan and what is the cost per person? Cheryl said there are 13 full time employees on	
103	the plan and the cost per person depends on the person's age. She said that last year	
104	employee's contribution was 15%, but because the cost of the plan decreased this year	
105	the employees are paying a 10% contribution.	
106	Motion by Tony Piemonte to accept the Benefits budget with Gross Expenses of	
107	\$452,260.00, Revenue of \$0.00 and Net Expenses of \$452,260.00 pending further review.	
108	Seconded by Dean Webster	
109	Tony said he made this motion because he feels the Recreation Director's position needs	
110	more supporting documentation to support this increase. Dean Webster said he agrees	
111	and doesn't feel this should be a full time position. He said they should not be	
112	rubberstamping budgets at this point and is willing to cut the budget at any cost. Cindy	
113	Buco said it is not known if that position is in the budget under the health insurance and	
114	asked Cheryl how this cut would affect this budget or the services to the employees.	
115	Cheryl said the NH Retirement lines are contractual agreements and have to be paid as	
116	they are based on payroll. She said the Taxes line cannot be changed and the Health	
117	Insurance line is also a contractual agreement at this point. She said the employees have	
118	been enrolled in this plan since December 1st and she doesn't know what happens other	
119	than the BOS would have to find the money somewhere else within the budget. Dean	
120	Webster said they need to be the voice of the average taxpayer at this point and they can't	
121	keep increasing the budgets. He said the \$16,000.00 Health Insurance benefit is a lot to	
122	offer for one employee. Cindy Buco said you need to take the position into consideration	
123	and feels that the Recreation Director's position is in the non-essential category given the	

124	roll of the position. Dean also stated the younger demographics are changing and the	
125	census is decreasing as well and a full time position should not have been created. Cathy	
126	Gorman said she agrees and feels that more research should have been done and she will	
127	hold her opinion until the Recreation budget is discussed at the next meeting. Michael	
128	Costanzo asked Tony how he came up with his figure and Tony said it was the amount	
129	the budget was at before the full time position was created. Cathy Gorman said if there is	
130	further concern in regards to this budget there is always the Public Hearing and	
131	Deliberative Session to discuss it as well.

136	Cheryl Eastman handed out an update to the Finance Director's budget and Cathy	
137	Gorman said the Budget Committee will discuss it at the next meeting.	
138	Cindy Buco stated that just because the Budget Committee voted to decrease the Benefits	
139	budget that doesn't mean it won't be funded another way. Dean Webster said there are	
140	alternatives and Cathy Gorman said it will create a good discussion for the BOS on	
141	Monday evening.	
142		
143	Cathy Gorman asked the Committee to review the minutes of Tuesday, December	
144	15, 2015.	
145	Cathy Gorman said the day of the meeting should be changed to read Tuesday and not	
146	Wednesday.	
147	Motion by Cathy Gorman to accept the minutes of Tuesday, December 15, 2015 as	
148	amended.	
149	Seconded by Michael Costanzo	
150	In Favor, Michael Costanzo, Cindy Buco, Cathy Gorman and Tony Piemonte.

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155	Cathy Gorman asked the Committee to review the minutes of Wednesday,

157	The minutes of Wednesday, December 16 <sup>th</sup> have been accepted as written.

159	Review of Warrant Articles
160	Cathy Gorman said Article 1 is the Town Officers and Article 2 does not have a dollar
161	amount to it yet therefore they will not be discussing these tonight.
162	
163	Cathy Gorman said they will discuss the Articles this evening but if the Committee feels
164	they need more information to make a decision they will defer the Article to the Public
165	Hearing.
166	
167	Special Warrant Article 3 – Road Improvement Capital Reserve Fund - \$435,000.00
168	Michael Costanzo asked how much money is in this fund currently. Cindy Buco said she
169	can tell the Committee what she knows, which is this amount will be completing the
170	work that needs to be done on the bridges. She said there are several phases and this
171	would be phase 1. She said even if there are funds in the account it is needed to fund the
172	projects. The consensus of the Committee is to move this article to Public Hearing to
173	have the DPW Director's input.
174	
175	Special Warrant Article 4 – Bridge Capital Reserve Fund - \$100,000.00
176	Dean Webster asked if there is already money is intended to be spent on a project that is
177	already developed, why is it in a Capital Reserve Fund and not from the budget? Cindy
178	Buco said some of the situations with the bridges are new and some are unexpected.
179	Cindy said the Town Engineer came in and explained the options to the BOS and this is
180	the best option for the least amount of money. Cathy Gorman said they Town sets aside a
181	certain amount of money in the fund each year for long term to continually work on
182	projects.
183	Motion by Michael Costanzo that the Budget Committee recommend this warrant article.

219	\$20,000.00
220	Dean Webster asked Cindy if this means that there are surplus in budget and it will be put
221	into this account up to \$20,000.00. Cindy said this is a portion of money the Town is
222	receiving and some of it will go into the General Fund and the \$20,000.00 will go into
223	this fund. She said she thinks this fund is just beginning and it can be used for town
224	disasters. Cathy Gorman said if the Committee wants to move this article to the Public
225	Hearing it is ok.
226	It is the consensus of the Committee to move this article to the Public Hearing.
227	
228	Special Warrant Article 9 – Revaluation Capital Reserve Fund - \$5,000.00
229	Motion by Tony Piemonte that the Budget Committee recommend this warrant article.
230	Seconded by Michael Costanzo
231	In Favor, Dean Webster - yes, Michael Costanzo- yes, Cindy Buco- yes, Cathy Gorman-
232	yes and Tony Piemonte - yes.

237	Special Warrant Article 10 –SSATP Expendable Trust Fund - \$5,000.00
238	Cathy Gorman said last year they were looking for \$2,500.00 but the amount was reduced
239	because they needed to create this fund first. Cindy Buco said this Committee has
240	already raised money and doesn't it to back into the General Fund. She said this is to
241	secure funding for their program. Dean Webster had several questions such as who did
242	the fundraising and if the committee was just being established. Cindy said the
243	Committee has been established but this trust funds has not yet been created.
244	The consensus of the Committee is to move this article to the Public Hearing for
245	further discussion.
246	

247	Warrant Article 11 – Library article for the extended day - \$5,800.00	
248	Kirsten Corbett is presenting this article.	
249	Kirsten said they are looking at opening the library either from 12 -6 or more likely 2-8.	
250	Tony asked if Friday night is busy and Kirsten said it could be if they were open. Cathy	
251	Gorman asked if they had surveyed the Town about this and Kirsten said that is why they	
252	are putting this on the ballot. Cindy Buco stated that Article 12 is dependent on Article	
253	11, but Article 11 is not dependent on Article 12. Dean Webster asked why article 12	
254	talks about 1 additional hour but Article 11 talks about 6 additional hours and Kirsten	
255	Corbett said that it will take more than 1 staff person to cover all of the hours. She also	
256	said that the 6 hours are covered in Article 11 but they will be making the Assistant	
257	Director's position full time, which makes it easier to move staff around.	
258	Motion by Tony that the Budget Committee recommend article 11.	
259	Seconded by Michael Costanzo.
