22	\$6,338.00 not increase.
23	Michael Costanzo said line 11 has his name spelled incorrectly.

29	Lee thanked Paula, Lynne and Cheryl and all Department Heads and Budget Committee
30	members during this process and feels it was a successful season.

165 Ron Dulong, member of the public said he was watching the last Budget Committee's 166 meeting and asked the Committee why the large amount of money was removed from the 167 budget. Lee Dube said there is no requirement for the Budget Committee to respond. 168 Tony Piemonte said he made the motion and feels the info that he was given was not 169 adequate enough to support the increase. Tony explained that with the Recreation 170 Director's position going from part time to full time it increased the Benefits budget and 171 he said it was handed to the Budget Committee without any public and feels there should 172 be public input in regards to the money that is allotted for a full time position. Ron 173 Dulong rebutted with stating that the full time position is already in place, therefore there 174 has to be enough money in the budget to cover it. Ron asks the Committee to consider 175 putting that amount of money back in to the budget tonight as it doesn't make sense to 176 have positions without the benefits. Lynne Blaisdell asked how the amount of 177 \$22,558.00 was removed and Tony said he went by the number that the budget was 178 previously at. Cathy Gorman stated it was reducing, SS taxes, Medicare taxes as well as 179 benefits. Lynne is concerned that the 1 position being discussed doesn't' equal the 180 \$22,000.00 that was cut. She said that there was more than that 1 position increased in 181 that budget. Lynne also said the position is already full time and the budget committee is 182 affecting other lines within the budget and asked the Budget Committee to consider 183 adjusting the amount to something more reasonable. Cathy Gorman said she was 184 planning to speak with the BOS last night but the meeting was cancelled so she didn't

185 have that chance and she is asking the BOS to provide guidance on that issue and Lee 186 Dube said the Budget Committee's role is to achieve a finalized proposed budget this 187 evening prior to Deliberative Session. He feels that the Budget Committee should fund 188 the Benefits budget and if there are adjustments to be made then it should be done at the 189 Deliberative Session. Deb Brown, Recreation Director came to the table and said, 190 although she is not required to divulge this information she said she is not taking the 191 health insurance. She said the Budget Committee reduced this budget without all of the 192 information needed forcing the BOS and other departments to take cuts within their 193 budget to cover this decrease. Deb said the amount of her benefit in this budget is 194 \$7,125.00 and if the Budget Committee feels strongly that this budget should be reduced 195 then this is the amount to reduce it by. Deb Brown hands the Budget Committee the 196 breakdown of the amount of benefits are now received. Deb said these are figures that 197 were given to a Recreation Board member by the Finance Director and wants the Budget 198 Committee to have the right information to make the best decision for all departments. 199 Michael Costanzo asked how much money did the Town save by changing health 200 insurance carriers and Dean Webster said that is irrelevant compared to this budget. Lee 201 Dube said there is value bringing this up. Dean Webster said the Committee needs to 202 deal with the line items presented that are in front of them. He said he doesn't understand 203 the purpose of the handout that he just received. He said his purpose for decreasing this 204 budget is because employees have a \$17,000.00 benefit, which is far greater than most 205 taxpayers. He said he'd like to bring this to the public's attention and he is voting on 206 these budgets with the tax payers in mind. Lynne said the budget that is being presented 207 reflects the actual cost for all full time employees benefits and the \$7,000.00 figure 208 presented represents the increased benefit of the position in question at this time. Dean 209 said it has nothing to do with the individual but it is the position and this should be an 210 adjustment for the BOS to change the process as to how the benefits are allotted per 211 employee. Cheryl Eastman said the benefits budget was created by her and it is a 212 responsible budget and this is what the town needs to fund these positions. She said the 213 money will have to come out of other areas if it is not put back in. 214 *Motion by* Cathy Gorman to modify the Gross Expense line from \$452,260.00 to

215 \$467,694.00.

- budgeting for all of them because if they don't take the insurance they receive the opt out

She also reminds the Committee that this budget turns back 306 \$55,000 per year to the town of help offset taxes for the following year and said her

307 hands will be tied to increase this amount.
