Motion passed unanimously. 23 24 **Station Manager's Report** 25 26 Chris has received an updated quote for the projector screen. If choosing a manual screen instead of automatic, it would be \$5,500 to purchase the screen. The price for an 27 automatic screen would be \$6,334, plus the amount to have an electrician run power to 28 29 30 A quote was received for the Tightrope software upgrade in the amount of \$17,450. The new Castus software that is supposed to be equivalent would be \$12,980. They also 31 32 offer some add-ons to that for an extra \$8,000, but Chris feels we don't need the 33 additional services like Video on Demand right now. Chris is accomplishing the same things with the Vimeo software right now. He is going to go back to Integrated 34 35 Solutions Group and see if they can better their price for the Tightrope, given the quote from Castus. 36 Chris talked with Lynne Blaisdell about recording other committees. Currently the 37 Selectmen, Planning Board, Budget Committee, and Cable Committee get recorded. 38 Boards that are not currently being recorded are Recreation, SSATP, Conservation, and 39 Zoning Board. In the original charter, it was stated that all committees and Boards 40

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would be recorded, if cable has the manpower. Chris feels if we have one additional

42	camera person, we could have the manpower to do them all. There was general
43	discussion of how Chris programs the recordings of the meetings to run on Channel 17.
44	Camera operator Dan Peters has said he would like to get more hours, but Chris feels
45	that having another person available as a back-up would be helpful.
46	• There will be a tree lighting on December 4 at 6:30 p.m.at the town hall. Chris will be
47	recording the event. He would like to explore the costs for a low-light camera for events
48	such as this, or the Spooky Walk in October.
