



45 Members agreed the copy should read “Sandown Conservation Property” instead of  
46 “Town-Owned Conservation Property.”

47  
48 Members discussed where the signs should go and determined there should be (2) on the  
49 Porter Property, (3) on the Hersey Property, (1) at the Old Meeting House, (4) at the  
50 Minton Property, (1) at Morrison Lane and two extra signs.

51  
52 **MOTION:** Mr. Traeger made a motion not to exceed \$1,000 for the purchase of 13  
53 aluminum signs that read “Sandown Conservation Property, Public Welcome” to be paid  
54 from the Sandown Conservation Fund. Mr. Major seconded the motion.

55  
56 *Discussion:* Mr. Major questioned if the town owned the parcel at the intersection of  
57 Fremont Road and Phillips Road. Members noted they did not.

58  
59 All members voted in favor. The motion passed.

60  
61 **Old Business**

62 Members discussed the warrant article and why it might have failed. Members agreed the  
63 wording was slightly confusing and noted they should have tried to clean up the language  
64 a bit so it was easier to understand.

65  
66 **MOTION:** Mr. Traeger made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Butler seconded the motion. All  
67 members voted unanimously in favor. The motion passed. Meeting adjourned 8:10 p.m.
