51 Mr. Gilday handed out some educational material to have at the booth as well as samples  
52 of various plants and herbs that can be found in this area.

#### 54 **Old Business**

55 Mr. Major noted the Eagle Scout project building a trail on Wells Village is making  
56 progress. They walked the property and mapped a route. Mr. Beucler has what he needs  
57 and is hoping to start in November.

59 Mr. Gilday met with Fish and Game on a project and they told him that the US  
60 Department of Interior has listed the northern long-eared bat as endangered. It's another  
61 species such as the blandings turtle that developers will need to be educated on—  
62 specifically on when to cut trees. The bats have a six week period in the summer when  
63 they nest in certain types of trees and habitat. In the winter, they go underground or in  
64 caves to hibernate. Clear cutting trees will disturb and kill the bats. The Army Corp of  
65 Engineers and the EPA will do acoustical monitoring and inventories of types of trees to  
66 see if there is suitable habitat and monitor the situation. The obligation right now is to  
67 educate ourselves and know there is a new endangered species.

#### 69 **New Business**

70 Mr. Butler noted that the water level at the community garden well is below the pipe. He  
71 suggested maybe putting in a longer pipe next year.
