32	Elm Tree Status
33	Bartlett Tree Experts came out last Thursday and applied Fortiphite to the
34	Elm Tree. The Fortiphite will help improve plant health following transplant
35	shock. They will be coming out again to do more work to get the tree ready
36	for winter. Mr. Butler mentioned that Bartlett Tree Experts suggested to put
37	a silt fence around the tree to help protect it from the snow, salt, and sand
38	that will be used during winter. There are several different silt fencings that can be used around the tree. Mr. Butler would like to get a 4-foot fence

40	around the tree. Mr. Gilday mentioned that getting a special paper to wrap

- around the tree to help keep bugs, animals, and even the sand and salt off the
- 42 tree. Mr. Gilday donated towards the care of the tree. Mr. Butler asked the
- Commission if they had any issues with him using the donation from Mr.
- 44 Gilday to purchase the silt fence for around the tree. The Commission has no
- issues with Mr. Butler using the donation for the fencing. Thank you, Mr.
- Gilday, for your donation to help maintain the Princeton Elm.

- 49 Mr. Butler has been working with Mr. Gilday about having the Ross
- 50 Property resurveyed. At the last meeting Mr. Butler asked the Commission
- to look over the RFP Proposal and asked if anyone had any changes or
- suggestions for the proposal. The purpose for having the land resurveyed is
- so the Commission knows where the property lines are, and they can place
- the proper signage on the property. Mr. Butler would like to have a
- professional land surveyor come in and review the old survey plans.
- By Sandown Tax Maps 14-19-38 and 14-19-86 there are so questions about
- 57 the property lines. Mr. Butler would like to use granite markers to make the
- property lines. The Granite Markers are easier to see then a metal rod in the
- 59 ground. Mr. Butler would like this survey done before the Commission starts
- putting signs up along the property lines. Mr. Butler would like to have the
- proposals from the license land surveyors by December 1st and the
- 62 Conservation Commission will vote on which proposal they will use. Mr.
- Butler and Mr. Gilday both have a few proposals. Mr. Carey asked Mr.
- Butler if the new survey plans will be recorded. Mr. Butler is not sure if the
- plans will need to be recorded. The License land surveyor will let the
- 66 Commission know if they need to record the new plans.
- In Mr. Butlers proposal he starts that he would like the surveyor to cut back
- vegetation and place the property markers. The cleaning back of the
- vegetation will help keep the property markers noticeable.
