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57 Side Entrance to Town Hall

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59 The committee members discussed the concern regarding the outside side entrance doors to 60 Town Hall. Michelle commented that some disabled and elderly have fallen and certainly struggle with that entrance way. The landing is small and the door swings outward, forcing you 61 to sometimes step back to open the door, creating an unsafe situation. The steps themselves 62 63 cause problems for some residents. Even though the handicap entrance is clearly marked at the 64 other entrance as well as the handicap parking, some residents continue to use the entrance with the stairs. The committee discussed some options that included a handicap push button for the 65 66 door, a ramp, redesigning the entry way etc. The reason this is a timely situation is that the 67 Board of Selectmen will be discussing warrant articles in the near future and 2 of those articles 68 may affect this area: the paving of the parking lot and the repair/replacement of the roof.

70 It may be too late to obtain adequate design, quotes etc. but the situation should be brought to the

71 Board of Selectmen's attention so that they can discuss and hopefully consider this situation

when they are approving warrant articles. Maybe the paving of the parking lot should be delayed

one more year and should include the redesign of the entry way in a single warrant article. This

may be more attractive to the voters. The Selectmen will meet on Monday evening to discuss

warrant articles and Paula will talk to Lynne and the Selectmen about the above situation.
