

SANDOWN LOCAL ENERGY COMMISSION

PUBLIC MEETING

April 18, 2011

Mr. Bruce Cleveland, Chairman opened the Public Session at approximately 7:12 P. M.

Motion by Mr. Devine to appoint Mr. Barczak's and Mr. Butler's to one year terms on the LEC. Seconded by Mr. Traeger. The vote was unanimous to accept Mr. Barczak and Mr. Butler for one year terms.

Selectman Devine swore Mr. Barczak and Mr. Butler in after the vote and they became voting members.

Motion made by Mr. Barczak to accept the meeting minutes from 3/3/11 as written. Seconded by Mr. Barczak. Motion passed with 2 in favor with Mr. Butler and Mr. Devine abstaining.

There was a discussion on the cursory energy audit conducted in December. It was decided to pick a date in May to have Peregrine Energy present the results of the audit to different department heads. Mr. Traeger will contact John Snell to secure a date for that meeting.

There was discussion on the lights at the transfer station. An "as built plan" will be made to try to assess the costs of replacing the lighting with town owned lights that can be turned on/off as needed. The LEC will flush out the return on investment on the light replacement project before presenting this option to the Board of Selectmen.

There was a discussion on Sandown Old Home Days. Mr. Traeger will contact the Chairman of the Sandown Old Home Days Committee about an energy theme for this year's celebration

There was a discussion on cooperative oil purchases with other towns.
