PUBLIC MEETING

June 13, 2011

Mr. Bruce Cleveland, Chairman opened the Public Session at approximately 6:10 P. M.

There was discussion on the lights at the transfer station. Mr. Cleveland will do a Return on Investment spreadsheet with existing lights compared to new lights and town ownership of poles. Mr. Patterson will do a design of new lights and poles.

There was a discussion on holding an Energy Fair at Sandown Old Home Days. Mr. Barczak reached out to PSNH but they did not have any help to offer. He is going to contact someone from the Atkinson Energy Fair. Mr. Butler had a couple of suggestions, such as poster boards displaying the mission of the LEC and projects we are working on. Mr. Patterson is going to contact a few local companies as regards to interest in participating in the Energy Fair.

Kevin Major and Ryan Patterson expressed an interest in joining the LEC, the members present discussed this and agreed that both individuals would be valuable contributors to the team. Mr. Cleveland will request in writing that the Board of Selectmen appoint them.

Mr. Cleveland updated the LEC activity sheet. The library has taken ownership of the light meter and temperature gun and will lend out to the public. Mr. Cleveland is speaking to the Road Agent with regards to getting a new waste oil burner for the town shed.
