16 **Review of Minutes of Previous Meetings**

18 MOTION by Tim Rand to approve the minutes of 05/06/15 as written  
19 SECOND by Anthony LoConte  
20 MOTION passed unanimously

22 The Committee officially welcomed Bob Brouder as the newest member.

24 **Budget**

26 Steve Brown was unable to attend the meeting but relayed a request for the committee to  
27 approve 2 expenditures.

29 MOTION by Paula Gulla to expend up to \$90 from the marketing budget for lawn signs  
30 SECOND by Anthony LoConte  
31 MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY

33 MOTION by Paula Gulla to expend \$50 with Hampstead Print and Copy for  
34 approximately 50 posters

38 **Beer Tent**

40 Bob Brouder stated the Historical Society is very interested in sponsoring the beer tent.  
41 President Jim Weber will make contact with Paula to discuss the details of what is needed  
42 for the liquor license and who to contact. Anthony suggested that the Board of Selectmen  
43 be kept apprised of this subject. Someone will attend a future Selectmen meeting to keep  
44 them up-to-date.

46 **Banners**

48 Karen stated she was in touch with the gentleman who provided the banners and it is  
49 likely we will receive 2 additional banners with the new date.

53 The committee received confirmation that the tractor pull will not conflict with the 9/12  
54 Old Home Day Fall Festival event.

58 Karen stated she has spoken with quite a few people and they are not happy about the  
59 earlier start time for the parade.

61 MOTION by Tim Rand to move the parade back to noon

62 SECOND by Karen Jortberg

63 MOTION WAS TABLED

65 The committee discussed whether to move the parade start time back to later in the  
66 morning and they decided to hold off until the next meeting to solidify this item. Both the  
67 Fire Chief and the Police Chief will have input that may affect this decision. Neither  
68 could attend this meeting but they will be invited to the 6/3/15 meeting and Karen will  
69 talk to them as well. Karen also said she has had no answer so far from the Pipe and  
70 Drum Corp. Anthony said the Sons of Italy Band will perform for \$10000 plus pizza and  
71 drinks.

73 **Rides & Entertainment**

75 Since Rick and Bev DeLuca were not present at the meeting, these topics will be  
76 discussed at the next meeting.

78 Karen did mention that the Tom Towler Band is interested in playing for the event.

80 **Citizen of the Year**

82 Paula asked for the committee's approval to make the following changes to Citizen of the  
83 Year selection process.

85 Two candidates will be selected this year – Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the  
86 Year.

88 Residents will still be able to submit a nomination but there will no longer be a 10  
89 signature requirement. Letters will be sent to the area groups such as the LIONS Club,  
90 Scouts, etc. to see if they would like to submit a nomination.
