43 **Marketing**

45 Bob Brouder noted that the school has never responded to the request to distribute flyers
46 so that is no longer an option for marketing.

48 Bob was able to make 500 black and white copies of the event day flyers for no charge.

52 The Hippo newspaper article should be out in this week's Thursday publication.

54 Bob relayed information that all the banners will need replacing next year. They have
55 been taped up but are not holding up well.

59 Hampstead Dance has found an area just to the right of the building where they feel is flat
60 enough for the dancers and still in proximity to the music. This area will be roped off in
61 the morning until after their performance at 10:00 -10:30 am.

63 The Historical Society would like to have the cannon on the Recreation field near their
64 table for people to see. The cannon weighs approximately 800 lbs, can be rolled onto the
65 field and is about 6 feet wide by 10 feet in length. The Recreation Director will be
66 contacted to be sure there are no issues or concerns with the cannon on the field.

109 the next several weeks after that. The consensus is to meet on that Tuesday to firm up
110 paperwork and any last minute reimbursements and meet again later to review how the
111 event went and discuss the warrant article for next year and any other matters.
