30	Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Ordinance
31	
32	The purpose of this Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Ordinance is to provide
33	for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Sandown though the
34	regulation of non-storm water discharges to the storm drainage system to the maximum
35	extent practicable. The IDDE ordinance establishes methods for controlling the
36	introduction of pollutants into the municipal separate storm sewer system (MS4) in order
37	to comply with requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
38	permit process. The objective of this ordinance is to:
39 40	1. Regulate the contribution of pollutants to the MS4 by storm water discharge by
40 41	any user.2. Prohibit illicit connections and discharges to the MS4.
+1 42	3. Establish legal authority to carry out all inspections.
43	The Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Ordinance is mandated by the Federal

44 45 Government and the MS 4 Permit.
