- staying the extra hour as to make it easier to budget and for the Budget Committee. Ms.
- Tapley is also the Administrative Assistant to the Conservation Commission and Zoning
- Board of Adjustments and she does plan on asking both to consider changing her hours.
- Mr. Meisner mentioned that the Board should look over the Ads line of the budget and to
- possibly increase that line item as the price to put an ad in the newspaper has been going
- 67 up.
