Public hearing for review of a Conditional Use Permit application submitted by Eversource for proposed utility maintenance on the existing R193, 115 kV transmission line in Sandown, NH. Eversource proposes to replace three existing 115 kV transmission poles on the R193 line.

Vicki Chase Senior Project Manager from TRC presented Eversource's Amended Conditional Use permit, along with Jeremy Fennell from Eversource.

A Conditional Use Permit was issued on July 17,2018 for 51,787 square feet of temporary impact for replacement of structure on the adjacent H141 line, and some of the accesses in wetland (totaling 11,867 square feet) for the H141 line have been left in

anticipation of the upcoming replacements. Eversource proposes to replace three existing

115kV transmission poles on the R193 line in Sandown. Three wooden poles that have been damaged by woodpeckers and weathering issues will be replace with steel poles.

75 Access to and around the poles to be replaced will require earth disturbance. Work pads

around the poles along the R193 line will be 100feet by 100feet. Timber mats will be

used to access pole removal and installation sites located within wetlands.

Eversource plans on starting the work April 1st and 16,468 square feet of new timber

79 matting will be put down. Eversource had to go before the Sandown Conservation

80 Commission because of the wetland impacts before going to the Planning Board. The

Sandown Conservation Commission sent a favorable letter to the Planning Board on

82 Eversource's behalf.

When Eversource did their inspection of the lines last year the R193 lines didn't need replacement. Inspecting them farther they need replacement and Eversource would like to do them before they finish up replacing the other lines in the H141 transmission lines.
