Mr. St. Amand 21 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor, Mr. Ardolino and Mr. Longchamps abstained. 22 The motion passed. 23 24 Review of 7/31/14 Minutes 25 **MOTION:** Mr. True made a motion to accept the 7/31/14 minutes as written. Mr. Ardolino 26 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor, Mr. Longchamps and Mr. St. Amand 27 abstained. The motion passed. 28 29 Review of 8/28/14 Minutes 30 MOTION: Mr. True made a motion to accept the 8/28/14 minutes as written. Mr. Meisner 31 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor. Mr. Longchamps, Mr. St. Amand and Mr. 32 Ardolino abstained. The motion passed. 33 34 **Reappointment of Members** 35 Mr. Meisner noted he had no issue if someone else wanted to step up and be Chairman. He 36 has been Chairman for 5-6 years and would be happy to turn it over to someone else. 37 38 **MOTION:** Mr. True made a motion to appoint Mr. Meisner as Chairman. Mr. Ardolino 39 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor, Mr. Meisner abstained. The motion passed. 40 41 Mr. Meisner accepted the position of Chairman. 42 43 **MOTION:** Mr. Meisner made a motion to appoint Mr. True as Vice Chairman. Mr. Ardolino 44 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor. Mr. True abstained. The motion passed. 45 46 Mr. True accepted the position of Vice Chairman.

48 Mr. Meisner made a motion to reappoint Mr. St. Amand for a three-year term. Mr. True 49 seconded the motion. Members voted in favor. Mr. St. Amand abstained. The motion passed. 50 51 Mr. True made a motion to reappoint Ms. Green as an alternate for a three-year term. Mr. St. 52 Amand seconded the motion. All members voted in favor. The motion passed. 53 54 **Review of Application** 55 Mr. Dan Dillon of 6 Second Street, M29 L53 submitted an application for a Variance from 56 Article II, Part A, Section 15 to permit the installation of a replacement septic system closer 57 than 75' from wells and wetlands. 58 59 The Board reviewed the application to determine if the submission was complete. Mr. 60 Meisner noted the criteria questions had been answered; the application fee was submitted 61 and there were 8 envelopes for abutters with postage submitted. 62 63 Mr. True and Mr. Ardolino confirmed the abutters list that was submitted was correct. 64 65 Members clarified that the application was for setbacks to wetlands, the neighbors well, and 66 the homeowners well. 67 68 Mr. Longchamps didn't feel it was clear that they were including both wells. Mr. Meisner 69 noted he could ask all of his questions at the public hearing when the applicant/surveyor 70 would be present. 71 72 The board also questioned if the setback needed to include the tank or just the leach field. Mr. 73 Meisner thought it did need to include the tank but will check into that. 74 75 The board felt the application was complete. 76 77 **MOTION:** Mr. True made a motion to accept the application submitted by Mr. Dan Dillon 78 of 6 Second Street, M29 L53 for a Variance from Article II, Part A, Section 15 to permit the 79 installation of a replacement septic system closer than 75' from wells and wetlands. Mr. 80 Ardolino seconded the motion. 81 82 Discussion: Mr. True questioned if the home was occupied. Members confirmed it was not 83 occupied. 84 85 All members voted in favor. The motion passed. 86 87 MOTION: Mr. True made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Ardolino seconded the motion. All 88 members voted in favor. The motion passed.
