## Saugus Board of Selectmen June 17, 2008

The Saugus Board of Selectmen met on June 17, 2008 at 7:30 PM in the Town Hall Auditorium, 298 Central Street. Present were: Selectmen Stephen Castinetti, Stephen Horlick, Peter Rossetti Jr. and the Chairman Donald Wong. The Town Manager Andrew Bisignani was also present. Michael Kelleher was absent.

Invited guests: None this evening.

Approval of minutes: June 10, 2008.

Mr. Rossetti moved to approve the June 10 minutes. Chair seconds. Vote: 4-0. <u>Continued hearings:</u> None scheduled for this evening.

Public hearings:

<u>7:30</u> Charlie Youssef Inc. d/b/a Charlie's Pizzaria, 304 Lincoln Avenue, for Common Victualer's License; for Entertainment License for televisions & for 3 coin operated devices.

Elie Youssef, 4 Howard St. was present and explained request and said the I/I fee has been paid. The Chair asked what the 3 coin ops will be. Mr. Youssef explained the company, Action Jackson, has all MA approved games and he wont have violent games. The Chair asked if any are gambling games. Mr. Youssef said no. Mr. Horlick asked number of seats. Mr. Youssef said 20. Mr. Horlick said he's requesting hours of 6AM to 11PM Sunday through Saturday. Mr. Youssef said yes. Mr. Rossetti asked about deliveries. Mr. Youssef said yes and will offer take out and sit down. Mr. Rossetti asked if he will have a driver on staff. Mr. Youssef said yes. Mr. Horlick asked if he was aware of no deliveries before 7AM.
