NEW BUSINESS

Request for Variance 6 Birch Street - Rudolph D. D'Amico - Ed Kingman

Reduce setback from wells from 100' to 50' per 310 CMR 15.405(1)(g). Reduce setback from cellar wall from 20' to 13' per 310 CMR 15.405(1)(b).

Mr. Edward Kingman was present for the septic variances at 6 Birch St. There is no public water located on this street and the three houses are on wells. Mr. Kingman stated this was the best place for the septic system. At this time there are no plans for public water on this street.

Ms. Hallal would like to see both wells tested for nitrates.

Mr. McLintock made the motion to approve the septic variance for 6 Birch Street, seconded by Mr. Costa and so voted unanimously.

Request for Variance 74 Roosevelt Street – Firmo Benros – Caputo & Wick LTD.

Reduction of system location setbacks from property line 310CMR 15.405(I)(a) Pump chamber - $6\pm$ ' (4' \pm reduction) and "system sand" - $8'\pm$ 2' \pm (reduction). Sieve analysis in lieu of percolation testing 310CMR 15.405(i)(9i).

Reduction of the requirement of a 12" separation between tees and high groundwater. One inch min. provided.

Reduction of the four foot minimum depth to groundwater. 2' separation provided with

Enviro-septic wastewater treatment system 2' reduction.

Mr. Allan Shear of Caputo & Wick LTD was present for the septic variances at 74 Roosevelt St. Ms. Hallal would like to see a poly-barrier around the portion of the leaching field that are requiring the variance.

Mr. McLintock made the motion to approve the variance request for 74 Roosevelt St, seconded by Mr. Costa and so voted unanimously.

Request for a hearing regarding the FY 2014 Annual Disposal Bill for 567 County St-Jay Vierra.

Application received on July 17, 2013.

Mr. Jay Vierra and Ms. Cynthia Vierra were present for this discussion. Mr. Vierra stated he forgot to submit the application and he has had a dumpster since 1990's.
