PUBLIC HEARING

The Conservation Commission of the Town of Seekonk in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, and/or the By Laws of the Town of Seekonk shall hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, October 4, 1984, at 7:30 P.M. in the Town Hall, 100 Peck St., Seekonk, MA 02771, upon the application of Tasca Lincoln Mercury, 200 Fall River Avenue, Seekonk, MA.

The proposed project is to pave some 0.90 acres for a parking lot on Fall River Avenue. This property, owned by Ford Leasing Development Company, will be used as a storage area by Tasca Lincoln Mercury, 170 Fall River Avenue, Seekonk, MA. The runoff from this area flows into a golf course where it feeds into a number of water holes. It is for this reason that this application is being filed. A swale and a crushed stone filled ditch will intercept the flow and slow it down. In a ten (10) year-fifteen (15) minute storm, the swale and ditch will store the increased runoff, without taking percolation into account.
