PUBLIC HEARING


The Conservation Commission of the Town of Seekonk in accordance with General Laws, Chapter 131, Section 40, and/or the By Laws of the Town of Seekonk shall hold a Public Hearing on Monday, November 22, 1982, at 8:00 P.M. in the Town Hall, 100 Peck Street, Seekonk, Massachusetts 02771, upon the application of the Rhode Island Department of Transportation, Division of Public Works, State Office Building, Providence, Rhode Island.

The proposed project is to widen Interstate Route 195 from two (2) lanes to three (3) lanes (both ways), which involves the right-of-way area of Interstate Route 195 from the Runnins River to a point nine hundred (900[±]) feet, more or less, easterly of said Runnins River.

Plans are available in the Conservation Commission's office.
