This Determination does not relieve the applicant from complying with all other applicable federal, state or local statutes, ordinances, by-laws or regulations. This Determination shall be valid for three years from the date of issuance.

The applicant, the owner, any person aggrieved by this Determination, any owner of land abutting the land upon which the proposed work is to be done, or any ten residents of the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to request the Department of Environmental Protection to issue a Superseding Determination of Applicability, providing the request is made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and Fee Transmittal Form as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten days from the date of issuance of this Determination. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and the applicant.

1. Erosion control to be placed on the easterly side of construction.
2. No debris shall be placed in wetlands.
3. All excavated soil shall be removed from site.
