Consider approval of Regular Session Minutes of:

Mr. Costa made the motion to approve the minutes of February 25, 2015, seconded by Mr. Oliveira RN and so voted 3-0-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Review of the proposed Preliminary Plan of Subdivision – Curt Street Extension – Gorodetsky Engineering, LLC

Due to the Planning Board by April 10, 2015

Ms Hallal has reviewed the plans and the percolation tests need to be noted on the plan. The drainage structure will need to have the water table reading. The engineer and the owner are aware of this.

Hearing regarding Chapter II violations at 37 Hiller Drive – Thomas Grasso

Ms. Hallal received a complaint regarding the conditions of an apartment at 37 Hiller Drive. Upon the inspection of the property Ms. Hallal notice several violations and cited Mr. Grasso and ordered him to correct. Mr. Grasso is here to inform the Board that the house has been sold and is asking the Board that the new owner corrects these violation, since he is financially unable to correct these violations and the new owner has informed him he will be gutting the house.

The Board is concerned that currently there are no smoke or carbon dioxide detectors in the apartment and has ordered Mr. Grasso to install the smoke and carbon dioxide detectors before the weekend and to contact the Board of Health for the inspection once it is completed. The Board wants them installed prior to the weekend.

OLD BUSINESS

Review of the changes to the Seekonk Board of Health Rules and Regulations for Body Art Establishments and Practitioners.

On section 21.13.0(A) correct the typo in approval and section (b) change the word should to shall.

Mr. Costa made the motion to accept the changes to the regulation for Body Art Establishments and Practitioners with the changes, seconded by Ms. Oliveira RN and so voted unanimously.

Review of the changes to the Seekonk Board of Health Regulations 10.0.0 Stable Regulations.
