And the Seekonk High School. As well as The Senior Center, The Seekonk Library and The Meadows, the park adjacent the Seekonk Library.

Within the twenty-five applicants, only the Kevin Hurley Middle School was left out as there were no artist/performers who applied to present there.

Other criteria for awards were to give artist/performers from Seekonk the benefit of the doubt since The Council wishes to reward our close community while continuing to find creative and professional recipients from all around the region.

All twenty-five applicants were residents of Massachusetts.

The Council was faced with a modest endowment to award so that quickly eliminated applicant requests of over \$1000 because the Council decided that it would be too limiting to fulfill the objective.
