## ANNUAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT:

## **Proposed Article for Election of School Committee Members:**

Discussion ensued regarding a proposed warrant article to elect School Committee members. It was the consensus of the Board to have information prepared as a hand out for Town Meeting, which explains the different methods to elect School Committee members.

# **Budget Hearing:**

Discussion ensued regarding holding an informational session one week before the Annual Town Meeting to give residents a chance to ask questions on the financial articles. It was the consensus of the Board to schedule this hearing for Monday, April 28, 2008 at 7 pm.

#### **Solid Waste:**

Administrator Kellogg explained the solid waste budget and the change in the billing system. Residents using the Transfer Station will purchase a sticker and anyone that does not will have the option of purchasing stickers only for recycling and bulky waste. A notice will be sent out informing residents that it is time to purchase a sticker, but no bills will be mailed.

#### **Inspectional Services:**

The total amount of this budget will be increased by \$4,000 due to increases in electrical, plumbing and gas permit fees.

## **Highway Truck:**

The amount of this article will be changed to \$145,000 to cover the cost of a truck and plow for the highway department.

# Chapter 90 Article:

This is a new article that the Department of Revenue suggests be placed on the warrant. The purpose is to allow the Town to accept Chapter 90 funds.

## **Compactor Box:**

This is for the purchase of a compactor receiver box. The funds will come from the enterprise fund and will not impact the tax rate for FY09.

## **Medicare Article:**

Discussion ensued regarding retirees changing to Medicare. This would be a savings for the Town. This will be discussed further at the Finance Committee meeting at 6:00 pm.

#### **Prior Year Bills:**

These are FY07 invoices that were not given to the Town before July 1, 2007.

## **Disposal of Surplus Items:**

This article is not necessary and will be removed before the warrant is posted.

<u>Selectman Macy moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Selectman Collingwood. The motion carried unanimously.</u>

Chairman Hannum adjourned the meeting at 6:00 p.m.
