The vehicle smells due to dog stains left by previous owner. The horn does not work and it makes loud sounds. It's on its last leg. She paid \$1,200 for the vehicle. The Board inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$1,750.

Goulart, Antonio – 2005 Cadillac SRX M# 439TGN


This vehicle was involved in an accident and has heavy damage. He submitted an estimate to fix the vehicle for about \$12,000. There is an issue with the insurance company and he has not been able to fix the vehicle. It has been sitting in his back yard for about a year.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$3,640.
