

BOARD OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS
September 14, 2013

The Board of Assessment Appeals met on Saturday, September 14, 2013 to hear appeals on the 2012 motor vehicle Grand List. Members present were Stephen Palmer, Betty Richards and David Harma. The meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

The following appeals were heard:

Berzon, Patti (Ostrover, Patricia) - 2004 Toyota Sienna ID# 5TDBA22C14S026277
Ms. Berzon feels the assessment on the vehicle is too high. It has over 200,000 miles. The electric windows and cruise control do not work and there is no back seat. The Board inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$6,000.

Lopes, Susan – 2003 Toyota Avalon ID# 4T1BF28B23U290193
Ms. Lopes feels the assessment is too high. The vehicle has about 150,000 miles and is in fair condition. It was purchased six years ago for \$13,000 but she feels the current value of the car is \$5,200. The Board inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$4,550.

Bourque, Constance – 2012 Eclipse horse trailer ID# 1E9BH1023CS401916
Ms. Bourque purchased the trailer for \$8,100 on August 24, 2011. The base price for this trailer is \$6,000. Her trailer has extra windows. It is a ten foot trailer with a bumper pull. There is no changing room. She submitted pictures. She feels the current value is \$5,995.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$5,110.

Ali, Giumazie – 1998 Buick Riviera ID# 1G4GD2214W4704171
Ms. Ali paid \$1,000 for the vehicle with 154,000 miles. The Board inspected the vehicle.

Decision: The Board voted unanimously to reduce the assessment to \$1,400.

There being no appeals, the meeting was adjourned at 11:00 a.m.
