- 1. Call to Order 6:00 pm
- 2. Turf Field Update
 - a. All is going according to plan. Construction starts May 1st.
 - b. Coaches have been notified about parking and foot traffic inconveniences.
- 3. Turf Ground Breaking Ceremony
 - a. Announced that on May 3rd at 11 am on Palmer field. Ed Habarek will lead a ceremony acknowledging the start of construction.
 - b. 11 Student-athletes and a few available coaches will be in attendance. Aside from A. Morrison, Dr. Riley, Dr. Murphy, B. Morrone and M. MacDonald to represent the school district.
- 4. Ticket Sales for SHS Turf Field
 - a. Morrone recommended that we maintain the current ticket status of Football games only. In light of the favorable community vote towards the Athletic Fields Bond. Committee agreed.
 - b. Tickets for Thanksgiving will be \$3 and \$2 pre-sale and \$5 for all on Gameday. It worked very well for Westerly last year (2012).
- 5. Fall and Winter ReCaps
 - a. Presented by Mr. Morrone, accepted by the Committee.
- 6. Possible New Academic Standards
 - a. Presented by Mr. MacDonald, a policy increasing academic standards at SHS to be beyond the CIAC standard (0.6 GPA) to a Simple GPA of 2.0. Numbers were presented to the committee to support the data. Students in attendance agreed with the policy.
 - b. Well Received by the committee, with additions including assistance (Guidance staff, teachers, coaches and Athletic Directors) to student-athletes struggling to meet and/or maintain the new standards added to the document.
- 7. New Supervision
 - a. Morrone asked about proper supervision for the new turf field and the multiple new night events. A hired Site Supervisor for Field Hockey, B+G Soccer and B+G Lacrosse would be needed to support the coaches and Athletic Directors. Morrone and MacDonald would still be responsible for the Football games (due to the larger attendance/ticket sales).
 - b. A \$30 stipend would be required, with initial financial impact being approximately. Fall of 2013 = \$450; Spring of 2014 = \$480.
 - c. Committee agreed the costs would come out of Football and Basketball Ticket revenue.
