Mr. Haberek read the Annual Town Budget proposed by the Board of Finance, recommending that a budget totaling \$55,276,098 with a 15.63 mil rate be sent to the Board of Selectmen for Town Meeting.






Those voting in favor of said item will vote "YES", and those voting against said item will vote "NO".
