MEETING MINUTES

1) Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance

Chairwoman Tibus called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

2) Remarks of Visitors

Proposed stop sign at intersection of Hewitt Road & Richmond Lane, Mystic

Dan O'Neill, Mystic, CT

Resides at corner where stop sign installation is being proposed, wondering why placement recommended at that location.

Steve Lake, Richmond Lane, Mystic Questioned why stop sign was proposed for this location.

Joe Bragaw, Director of Public Works, Town of Stonington Referred to the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, particularly the recommendation that "yield" or "stop" signs should not be used for speed control, and that these signs should not be installed on the higher volume roadway. Director Bragaw stated he will work with the Chief to find additional ways to deter speeding, and is looking into the sight line of the curve at this location.

Chief Stewart stated that although he understands the request for a stop sign at this location, he will follow recommendation of Director Bragaw. The sharp curve his currently his greatest concern, and there has been a requested made for additional retroflective signage at this area.

Request for Clearer Markings at Jackson Avenue, Mystic CT

Chief recommends yellow curbing on Jackson Avenue to better inform drivers that parking is restricted within 25 feet of an intersection.

Joe Bragaw will ensure Jackson Avenue is priority on list for road painting. He also stated that a group of civil engineering students from UCONN will be conducting an audit of traffic signs for a course project, and will report back to him with a list of non-compliant signage.

Chief Stewart stated that due to the number of participants at the Turkey Trot, it should be ensured that all points of coverage are clear, and recommended hiring an Officer and reaching out to fire personnel. The Chief also stated that YMCA should check back closer to that date to ensure no Town projects are occurring at that time.
