The Act modifies the State's jurisdiction over coastal resources, re-establishing a new Coastal Jurisdiction Line (elevation 2' (NAVD 88)). The amendment matches Town ZRs to the State law, limiting potential confusion when determining countable land for calculating bulk requirements.
