## **Current Business:**

- Sewer Tie-In fees:
  - The EDC is requesting that the Water Pollution Control Authority (WPCA) consider adding an installment payment plan option for deferred sewer benefit assessments and hook-up fees. Residential and Commercial developments currently require a "cash-in-advance" payment of the benefit assessment prior to issuance of a sewer construction permit. An installment plan will make Stonington a more competitive place for people to build.
  - o EDC members presented the initiative to the WPCA February 25<sup>th</sup>, it was accepted in confidence. Tom Gilligan, WPCA Director conducted a Survey on other CT towns' current Hook-up charge Payment Terms and conditions.
  - o EDC members will be attending the upcoming WPCA meeting Tuesday March 25<sup>th</sup> at the police station in order to provide support for the initiative.
