The Board of Finance held a special meeting on this date at the Police Department meeting room. Mr. Wheeler made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 19 meeting. Mr. Grimes seconded the motion and voting was unanimous.

Members received a letter from Chief Darren Stewart informing them of some Police accounts that will be over expended, particularly Overtime and Building maintenance. He mentioned that they are still anticipating reimbursement from the Federal government for overtime used during the flood.

Mr. Frishman called a recess at 8:51 p.m. to wait for the final count of the Budget vote.


Mr. Frishman recalled the meeting to order at 9:00 p.m.
