Call to Order

Chairman Carreau called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Lee made a motion to accept the November 6, 2008 minutes. Mr. Allyn seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved by the Commission.

Gwenmor Dock Application at 20 Roseleah Drive

Catbriar Lane Mystic Ct.

A motion was made by Mr. Lee that the commission does not object to the concept proposed by Mr. Neilson on the Catbriar Lane dock reconstruction, and it is consistent with the Mystic Harbor Management Plan. Mr. Washburn seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

Enders Island Shoreline Protection Restoration

A motion was made by Mr. Washburn that the commission does not object to the concept proposed by Mr. Neilson regarding the Enders Island Shoreline Protection Restoration, and it is consistent with the Mystic Harbor Management Plan. Mr. Lee seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

Roland Violate - New Fixed Pier - Masons Island Rd. Mystic Ct.

A motion was made by Mr. Allyn that the commission does not object to the concept proposed by Mr. Neilson regarding the New Fixed Pier for Roland Violette, and it is consistent with the Mystic Harbor Management Plan. Mr. Lee seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

DEP Permit Form – Dock at 31 Beach Dr. – Philip Savoie

A motion was made by Mr. Washburn that the commission does not object to the concept proposed for the dock at 31 Beach Dr., and it is consistent with the Mystic Harbor Management Plan. Mr. Lee seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.

DEP Permit Form – Dock at 30 Orchard Hill. – R. Bescher

A motion was made by Mr. Lee that the commission does not object to the concept proposed for the dock at 30 Orchard Hill, and it is consistent with the Mystic Harbor Management Plan. Mr. Washburn seconded the motion. It was unanimously approved.
