Ct 4351 BD - Policy Statements

Harbor Master Watts reported that the black sloop, CT 4351 BD was asked to move his boat from its anchorage. The boat was moved but moored on a private mooring without permission. The boat has been asked to move again.

A 34 ft white sloop, CT 2442 BA was blown on to the rocks during the last storm. The system in place worked; Harbor master Watts was notified of the incident, he was able to track down the owner of the vessel through the DEP, and the owner was able to rescue his boat. Harbor Master Watts also reported that

A discussion ensued as to whether boats should be prohibited from being left on moorings or anchorages during the winter months when they could become inaccessible.

East Fairway & T-1 Anchorage

Harbor Master Watts reported that 15 mooring are located in or near the East Fairway. Chairman Carreau has purchased three green buoys and three 75 lbs mushroom anchors to mark the western edge of the Fairway. The process of opening up the fairway will need to move slowly but deliberately.
