- 5. State of RI's Coastal Resource notice regarding Watch Hill Yacht Club's maintenance dredging.
- 6. State of Ri's Coastal Resource notice regarding renovations to the Weekapaug Inn.
- 7. Docko Engineering Company's application from John O'Brien for reconstruction of some stone walls. The only comments made by members this evening were that these stone walls would deter further erosion.
