# Regular Meeting

The 1378<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Stonington Planning and Zoning Commission was held on June 17, 2008 at the Mystic Middle School at 7:00 p.m. Present for the meeting were Commission members Lynn Young, Paul Altman, Paul Holland, Julianne McCabe, Chuck Sneddon; Alternate Rob Marseglia, Town Planner Keith Brynes, and Director of Planning William Haase.

Chairman Sneddon called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

Seated for the meeting were: Paul Altman, Paul Holland, Lynn Young, Julianne McCabe, and Chuck Sneddon presiding.

#### Minutes:

Director of Planning, Bill Haase presented the plan to the Commission. Commission members commented on the plan. Mr. Haase stated the plan would be taken to the Economic Development Commission meeting on June 23, 2008.

Chairman Sneddon called a five minute recess.

## **Public Hearings:**

Ms. McCabe read the call for Public Hearing A:

**PZ0810SUP South Broad Realty. LLC** - Special Use Permit application for approval of Restaurant (increase seating from 8 to 24 seats), additional four (4) outdoor seasonal seats, and associated signage & parking in existing structure. Property located at 76 South Broad St., Pawcatuck, CT. Assessor's Map 14 Block 2 Lot 11. Zone LS-5.

Ms. McCabe is recused. Seated for the Public Hearing were: Rob Marseglia, Paul Holland, Paul Altman, Lynn Young, and Chuck Sneddon, presiding.

This Public Hearing was continued from June 3, 2008.

David Rosenblum, applicant, spoke in rebuttal.

Chairman Sneddon asked if anyone wished to speak in favor, against, or with general comments. No one spoke.

Ms. Young motioned to close the Public Hearing and Mr. Altman seconded. Motion carried 5-0.

Ms. Young motioned to grant the request for waivers and Mr. Altman seconded. Motion carried 4-0-1.

Roll Call: Lynn Young – approve, Paul Altman – approve, Paul Holland – abstain, Rob Marseglia – approve, Chuck Sneddon – approve.

Ms. Young motioned to approve the Special Use Permit with two stipulations recommended by staff and a third stipulation added by the Commission and Mr. Altman seconded. Motion carried 4-0-1.

Roll Call: Lynn Young – approve, Paul Altman – approve, Paul Holland – abstain, Rob Marseglia – approve, Chuck Sneddon – approve.

### Stipulations:

- 1. The Town's maximum seating notice must be posted in a conspicuous location inside the restaurant.
- 2. A sign shall be installed on-site directing customers to the rear parking lot. This sign shall be limited to a maximum of four square feet per Section 1.2 of the Zoning Regulations.
- Handicapped parking shall be provided to the satisfaction of the Building Official.

Ms. McCabe read the call for Public Hearing B:

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**PZ0803SD & GPP James & Jacqueline Burgess & Susan Blaisdel**l – Subdivision & Groundwater Protection Permit Applications for a 26-lot subdivision of an approximate 50.54 acre parcel. Property located at 56 Jeffrey Rd., Pawcatuck, CT. Assessor's Map 17, Block 1, Lot 6, Zone RM-20.

This Public Hearing was continued from May 6, 2008.

Theodore Ladwig, attorney for the applicants presented the application along with Norm Theibault, engineer, and Bruce Hilleson, Traffic Engineer.

Chairman Sneddon called a five minute recess.

Mr. Brynes presented staff comments.

Ms. Young motioned to close the Public Hearing and Mr. Holland seconded. Motion carried 5-0.
