November 16, 2010

First Selectman Edward Haberek, Jr., reconvened the Special Town Meeting of November 3, 2010, adjourned to this date at 8:45 p.m. at the Stonington Town Hall.

Hearing no objection, the First Selectman dispensed with reading the call, which is recorded on the preceding page.

First Selectman Haberek read the results of the referendum vote on the question:
